Barb Hayek made a motion to amend the agenda to add Confirmation to New Business. Second by Mitchell Hayek. Motion carried. Mitchell Hayek made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Second by Barb Hayek. Motion carried.

Joining the meeting to discuss the Ministry Site Profile was chairman of the Call Committee Amanda Phillips. After discussion and two changes, the council endorsed the Ministry Site Profile. It will be sent to the NEIA Synod. Copies will be made available to the congregation.

Treasurer's Report – The checking account balance at the end of March was \$13,390.58. Sue Hoey made a motion to transfer \$3,390.58 to the General Savings and Emergency Fund. Second by Shirley Bergman. Motion carried. Sheila Collins made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second by Beth Stanek. Motion carried.

Secretary's Report – Cindy Gosse made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 13, 2023 council meeting. Second by Shirley Bergman. Motion carried.

Committee Reports

Hospitality – Barb Hayek has offered to get appreciation gifts for Sunday School teachers Katey Niichel and Crystal Lysne. The committee is working on gifts for graduates and Mother's Day.

Memorial – Shirley Bergman will resume being council representative for the committee.

Parish Ed – Lori Schutte is forming a VBS committee. Beth Stanek and Christy Phillips will be committee members. The curriculum has been ordered.

Presidents – No report.

Property – The church landscape was cleaned on March 27 by Ray Zummak, Wayne Schneider, Randy Frush, Kenny Schares, and Teri Schares. Furnace filters have been changed.

Scholarship – As of April 2 no applications were submitted for the EPIC Scholarship for 2023.

Technology – Cindy Gosse will have Premier Technology replace the Secretary's computer this month.

Worship and Music – Hymns have been chosen through June 4, 2023. Youth will sing in worship on April 23. Hymns were chosen with graduates in mind for worship on graduation day May 21.

Youth – A fun evening was enjoyed by 26 participants at the Waterloo Black Hawk hockey game on March 24.

Call Committee – The committee will meet with NEIA Synod representative Pastor Liz Albertson soon.

Council recognizes there are expanded and changing job duties of the secretarial position during the Call process and with the possibility of an interim Pastor. Beth Stanek made a motion for council president Christy Phillips to discuss the above changes with Secretary Jessica Saunders to determine if she is able to make the time commitment to meet these needs. Second by Cindy Gosse. Motion carried.

A date needs to be set for Confirmation. The decision will be tabled until council can determine when all assignments have been completed, the families' choice of date, and arrangements can be made with a supply or interim Pastor.

Summer Food Program – The Jesup Ministerial Association will be spearheading the Summer Food Program again during the summer months. The distribution will once again be from the St. Athanasius Gymnasium beginning Wednesday, May 31st and continue every two weeks until the last distribution on Wednesday, August 9th for a total of six distribution dates. ALC and Zion Jubilee are scheduled for June 14th and August 9th. Volunteers are needed at St. A's beginning at 4 PM to approximately 6 PM for these two dates to pack up the grocery items and help with loading items into participant's vehicles. A Volunteer sign-up sheet for ALC has been placed on the Usher's Stand. Please sign up if you are available on one or both dates. ALC has been asked to provide boxes of instant oatmeal. The number needed won't be known until later in May as the applications are not due back until May 19th. Last year 12 families were served; in 2021, there were 18 families. Therefore, at least 72 boxes of oatmeal are needed for the summer distribution. Your donations of oatmeal may be placed in the yellow grocery cart in the Lower Narthex.

In addition to the food items donated by the local churches, the Jesup Ministerial Association purchases food items from the Northeast Iowa Food Bank as the food can be purchased at a lower cost than at a grocery store (items churches are donating are typically not available through the Food Bank). If you would like to donate monetarily to this program, we will be having Noisy Offering in the months of May, June and July to assist with this ministry.
