Performers: Students wishing to perform should send an audition by video. Please sing two contrasting songs (one comedic and one dramatic), 16-32 bars long. Slate at the beginning of the video stating name, age, and name of songs. Please email your video to ashley@puttinonproductions.com by March 4, 2020. Designers/Directors: Students wishing to be a designer or student director/choreographer should email ashley@puttinonproductions.com. A short questionnaire shall be provided which you will need to return at your earliest convenience.

TIME COMMITMENT AND SHOWS:

All students, whether designer/technician or actor, will meet at POPs Studio, 2010 N. Sepulveda Blvd., Manhattan Beach (Behind Manhattan Bread & Bagel/Fresh Bros. Pizza) on March 13th at 3:30 pm.
