How can you expand and memorise vocabulary effectively?
By exposure
By focused study

- Incidentally

- Intentionally


## By exposure

With lots of comprehensible and interesting language input (reading and listening).


## By focused study

Selecting specific words and collocations and working with them until you have memorised them well.


## Steps for effective focused study

1. Create multiple associations

3. Practise recall


## Step 1. Create multiple associations

## Translate

Make connections between languages.
Pasear = to go for a walk

Learn collocations
Pasear por el campo
Pasear al perro

Create sentences
Me encanta pasear por el campo

## Make visual associations

- Read the words
- Associate them with a picture/drawing
- Use colour coding



## Make sound associations



- Listen to the words
- Say the words out loud



## Make kinaesthetic associations



- Write the words
- Associate them with gestures


Multisensorial language learning works best for memorising

## Effective ways of creating multiple associations

- "Multisensing" words

- Colour coding notes
- Personalising uocabulary notebooks
- Drawing uocabulary diagrams
- Designing and studying with flashcards


## "Multisensing" words

When checking single words in the online dictionary:
read, listen, (write) and repeat out loud


## Vocabulary notebook



## Colour coding




## Vocabulary diagrams



## Flashcards



## Flashcards



## Step 2. Practise spaced revision

Space out your revision periods. Repetitions spaced out over time generate greater long-term retention than crammed revision.
