It has been very rewarding to see the moms and their littles step in the pan then come in the house and wash their hands together. I have also noticed that the moms put their mask on when volunteers enter the house for protection of the volunteers and themselves. This is very important for the moms to learn how to follow the rules and how to be flexible as things sometimes change daily.

We have had one mom and her son leave CALM house to move into their own place here in Niceville! We are so thrilled that this mom saved her money, goes to church, works full time and gets her kid fed and clothed and to day care each day.

Our next mom has a new job and is doing well. Her little guy goes to a local day care and they are thriving. She is learning trust and forgiveness.

We have a new mom and her three little girls move in and they are all settling down and doing great. She keeps her kids fed and cleaned and is learning how to discern who is an o.k. person and who isn't.

Our most recent mom moved in at the end of August and delivered a beautiful baby girl via C-section on September 8th. Our very own house nurse, Leeann Peterson, attended her in the operating room! Mom and baby are doing great.
