Some parish council have started to install charging points.

These seem to be in areas where the county council has a funding initiative to support them being installed by parish councils.

Lewes District Council don't seem to have such a scheme as yet – it might be worth asking Johnny Denis to look into this.

I couldn't find details of any parish councils that have done this in Sussex.

The only grant I could see was LEVI but this is for the local authority and not parish councils.

From info that I found:

If funding is awarded to a parish, it seems to come with guidance around how far the charging point should be from residents (a certain walking distance from houses with only on street parking).

2 bays seem to always be required.

24 hour access seems to be required with no gates.

A plan for the ongoing management, financing and maintenance of the charging point needs to be developed.

A parish council needs to use the General Power of Competence to allow it to charge for charging. I could see any kind of costs for having a charging point but I get the feeling that it would be significant and that the parish council would need to provide some funding contribution if it manages to secure government funding. I have asked SDNPA if the CIL funding can be used for such a thing.
