DRAFT MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY MEETING OF FIRLE PARISH COUNCIL: Tuesday 9TH June 2026, 7.03pm, Firle Village Hall. **Members in Attendance:** Cllr Hill (Chair), Cllr Barr (Vice-Chair), Cllr James, Cllr Lance, Cllr Symes.

1. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:** None received.
2. **NO DECLARATIONS OF ANY INTERESTS AND NO REQUESTS TO CONSIDER FOR A DISPENSATION WITH RESPECT TO ITEMS ON THE AGENDA,** as required by the Members Code of Conduct were received.
3. **MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING:** The minutes of the annual meeting of Firle Parish Council held on 5th May 2026 were RESOLVED to be a correct record and were signed by the Chair.
4. **FINANCE:**
 - 4.1 The June finance report and bank reconciliation was RECEIVED and SIGNED and payments to be made were AUTHORISED.
 - 4.2 The Council reviewed the Asset Register and updated it with details of the condition of assets and their values; Cllr Symes will take photos of the unique assets as a record; the Clerk will confirm the registration of the War Memorial and Buttercross.
 - 4.3 The SDNPA's Reporting Requirements for 2025-26 CIL Parish Payments were RECEIVED and the Clerk will complete.
 - 4.4 The Council RESOLVED to appoint Mulberry LAS as the Internal Auditor for 2026-27.
 - 4.5 The updated Allocated Reserves for 2026-27 were AGREED.
5. **GRANT AWARDS:** None received.
6. **REPORT(S):**
 - 6.1 No reports from Local and District Councillors and the MP for Lewes were received but apologies were received from Cllrs Denis, Agace and O'Brien.
 - 6.2 The draft minutes from the LDALC AGM on 30th April 2026 were RECEIVED.
7. **CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED:**
 - 7.1 Wilder Ouse Conference 26th June – Sussex Wildlife Trust. This is in Lewes Town Hall, 9am – 4pm. NOTED, any parish councillors wishing to attend will email the Clerk.
 - 7.2 SDNPA Local Plan Consultation: NOTED with no response.
 - 7.3 Litter Bin Audit: The bins that belong to Firle Estate have been removed and there will be no charge to FPC; the Clerk will enquire about changing the emptying frequency in winter and request a cost for a single replacement bin at the cricket pitch; the Clerk will seek an alternative quote from the contractor advised by Seaford Town Council.
 - 7.4 Share Community Climate and Nature Case Studies in Lewes District: NOTED.
 - 7.5 Draft South Downs Open Space Study – SDNPA: Cllr Hill has checked the open spaces and they are all included.
8. **MATTERS ARISING:**
 - 8.1 Ecology projects were DISCUSSED: No suggestions have been received in response to the article in the parish magazine; the Council are interested in developing hedgehog pathways and habitats; the Clerk will contact Firle Primary School to see if they are interested in participating in the project.
 - 8.2 No further reports or updates on Fly Tipping were received.
 - 8.3 Confirmation of James MacCleary MP Q&A at Firle was NOTED as 6th Oct at 6pm.
 - 8.4 A resident's concerns over the poor mobile signal was DISCUSSED; the Clerk will contact O2 regarding its signal strength in the village.
 - 8.5 An update on the installation of House Martin nesting cups was RECEIVED from Cllr Hill: Firle Estate has placed nesting cups on key properties around the village further to Cllr Hill providing a list of suitable locations identified by the Lewes Swift Trust; several private residences have also installed nesting cups up on their properties and the Church has Swift boxes; it is considered that there are now plenty of nesting cups and swift boxes in the village; the Council AGREED to write a letter to thank Bob Baines and Firle Estate for the work they did to install nesting cups; the Council hopes that the once healthy population of house martins in the village along the Street may now return with the introduction of nesting cups.
 - 8.6 The Council DISCUSSED the consultation on the modification to the two unitary proposal received from East Sussex County Council, Eastbourne Borough Council, Lewes District Council and Rother District Council: The

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Council RESOLVED to support LDC option to remain in the current format; Cllr Hill will draft a response to be circulated to the council prior to submission.

9. HIGHWAYS:

- 9.1 The Council understands from ESH that the blocked drain by Redwood Cottage, Wick Street has now been cleared.
- 9.2 The Council understands the the blocked drain 42B, The Bostal has been cleared; Cllr Barr raised an issue with foliage overgrowth on the eastern side of the turning from Wick Street west and this was logged on the ESH portal.
