DRAFT MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY MEETING OF FIRLE PARISH COUNCIL: Tuesday 8th July 2025, 7.13pm, Firle Village Hall. Members in Attendance: Cllr Hill (Chair), Cllr Bolger, Cllr Lance, Cllr Symes. Members not in Attendance: Cllr Barr. Others Present: Lorna Thwaites, Clerk and RFO.

- 1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE: RECEIVED and ACCEPTED from Clir Barr.
- 2. NO DECLARATIONS OF ANY INTERESTS were received AND NO REQUESTS FOR A DISPENSATION WITH RESPECT TO ITEMS ON THE AGENDA, as required by the Members Code of Conduct.
- 3. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the ordinary meeting of Firle Parish Council held on 10th June 2025 were RESOLVED to be a correct record and were signed by the Chair.

- 8.3 Funds to cover the shortfall in fireworks costs R.Gravett: The Council reviewed the minutes of 6th June 2024 and AGREED that there has been a misunderstanding; when the Council was advised that Firle Bonfire Society was organising fireworks the Council understood that a grant application would be submitted if required; however, the Council now understand that fireworks were not being planned by Firle Bonfire Society and there had been a mis-communication; the Council AGREED that to avoid this happening in the future, all communications should be by email to the clerk.

- 9.1 The pothole outside the village hall is still pending.
- 9.2 Thanks were given for the clearing and cleaning of 30mph signs in the village that needed attention; Cllrs will check if any further signs need attention.

10. PLANNING: Applications Received:

- 10.1 SDNP/25/01672/FUL Proposal: Installation of PV panels to pitched roofs and replacement of existing roof covering with new concrete tiles to 5no bungalows Location: 1,3,4,5 And 7 School Bungalows, Bostal Road, Firle, East Sussex. (comments by 15 July 2025). COMMENTS AGREED NEUTRAL.
- 10.2 SDNP/25/02540/TCA Proposal: T1- Cherry- Reduce height and width of crown by 2m keeping wound size to a minimum, cutting to suitable growth points, keeping wound size to a minimum, leaving a well-balanced crown- the tree is excessively shading the garden and the work will reduce sail effect reducing the risk of limb failure Location: 18 The Street, Firle, East Sussex, BN8 6NR. (comments by 8th July 2025). COMMENTS AGREED NEUTRAL.
- 10.3 SDNP/25/02702/TCA Proposal: T1- Sycamore- Remove & Replace with similar T2- Beech Hedgerow- Reshape form after Sycamore removal. 3-4m Reduction over outbuilding. Remove Limb 1N over outbuilding Location: 53 Crossways, Wick Street, Firle, East Sussex, BN8 6LG (comments by 18 July). COMMENTS AGREED NEUTRAL.

11. MATTERS ARISING:

11.1 No further plans have been proposed for the car park: The Council discussed need for overflow car park in the summer and weekends and AGREED the following schedule for August: Cllr Bolger will do the first week; Cllr Symes the second week; Cllr Lance the third week; and Cllr Hill the fourth week.

- 11.3 The Council RESOLVED to support VJ Day activities on 15th August 2025 and have agreed a grant to the village hall committee for fireworks under item 6.1.
- 11.4 The Clerk has circulated some information on electric car charging points; the Clerk will ask Cllrs Denis and O'Brien if they are aware of any funding becoming available to parish councils; Cllr Bolger will investigate further.
