

Karen's catalogue continues to show her range and heart. Her singles include **"Home,"** released April 17, 2020; **"Cherry Blossoms,"** released June 26, 2020; **"Slipstream,"** released May 4, 2021; and **"Sitting Pretty,"** released May 18, 2025.

**"Home"** offers a message of support for anyone searching for lost hope. **"Cherry Blossoms"** captures Karen's romantic, reflective side while **"Slipstream"** ponders the possibility of influencing your destiny by riding the space and time continuum. **"Sitting Pretty"** is a celebration of female friendship, and the song lyrics were inspired by a real conversation. **Christmas (Live),** a three-song mini-album, was released on December 20, 2018, followed by **The Karen Fowlie Christmas Special (Live),** a 2021 live album of seasonal songs that was shared as a Christmas concert special on YouTube.

Beyond her recordings and live performances, Karen has spent a lot of effort creating space for others to be heard. She hosted weekly jams and gave voice / guitar lessons for two decades. She also created performance opportunities for students, emerging artists, and established local musicians through the **Fowlie and Friends Entertainment Society.** Karen produced variety shows, open mics, and community events, including a **Tribute to Canadian Women in Music** that received a note of support from **Sarah McLachlan.** More than 100 North and West Vancouver musicians took part in events Karen envisioned, and in 2018 she was presented with the **Arts and Culture Award for West Vancouver.**
