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1. Project Background

Path Insight, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, is actively participating in the restoration of Ivy Hill, a historic c.1840s stone farmhouse with resident curators, Allison and Jacob Cordell, with Maryland Department of Natural Resources. - Remove old stair. CMU wall, window well
- Level foundation where needed
- Remove staircase in existing structure

B. Framing & Structural Work

- Frame new 29' x 15' two-story addition
- 77 sq ft breezeway on each floor
- Install standing seam metal roof and connect to existing slate (or recommended method)

C. Exterior Finish

- LP SmartSide siding in selected finish
- White trim, composite deck, 4 exterior doors
- Gutters and downspouts
