


## UNDERMOUNT SINK CABINET GUIDE






FIRST, DEPENDING ON YOUR CABINET DESIGN YOU'LL NEED TO REMOVE EITHER THE FOWARD CORNER GUSSETS ① OR LEFT AND RIGHT SIDE SUPPORTS ② FROM THE TOP OF YOUR CABINET OPENING. THIS WILL ALLOW THE SPACE NEEDED FOR YOUR SINK BOWL TO INSTALL SMOOTHLY AND WITHOUT OBSTRUCTION.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS ONE OF MANY CORRECT WAYS TO INSTALL OUR UNDER MOUNT SINKS.

OCCASIONALLY COUNTER TOP SUPPLIERS WILL SUPPLY CLIPS AND ATTACH THE SINK TO THE
BOTTOM OF THE COUNTER TOP. THAT METHOD IS FINE. HOWEVER, SINKS SHOULD NEVER BE
SUPPORTED FROM THE BOTTOM. ALL METAL UNDER MOUNT SINKS SHOULD BE SUPPORTED BY
THE FLANGES ONLY.

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NEXT, FOR SINKS 54" AND UNDER OR WHEN USING THE SIDE OF THE CABINET AS THE ONLY SUPPORT FOR THE RIGHT AND LEFT FLANGE, THE AREA WHERE THE SINK WILL RESIDE NEEDS TO BE ROUTED DOWN 1/16" ③ SO THE SINK WILL BE FLUSH WITH THE TOP OF THE CABINET, ALLOWING THE COUNTER TOP TO REST SECURELY ON BOTH. IF YOUR SINK IS OVER 54", ADDITIONAL SUPPORT WILL BE NEED TO BE ADDED (SET DOWN 1/16" FROM THE TOP OF THE CABINET) TO SUPPORT TO FRONT AND REAR FLANGES.
