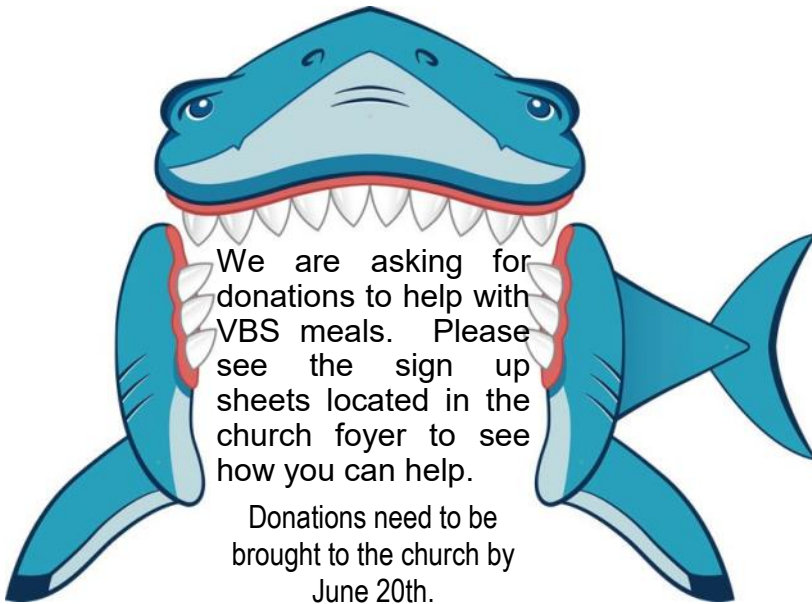
Scripture Reflections:
