District President Saunders has been informed of this decision by the voter's assembly and Steve Butler has been in contact with our DP to once more get the proper protocol in place.... So, what can you do? If you think of a pastor that may fit in well here at Grace and that they might consider receiving a call. please give their name to Steve Butler, Jon Betz or Scott Steffens. There is no need to be alarmed or to start panicking, everything is fine and with the incredible guidance of the HOLY SPIRIT and your prayers this will be a seamless transition. # **MILES OF DIMES!!**


