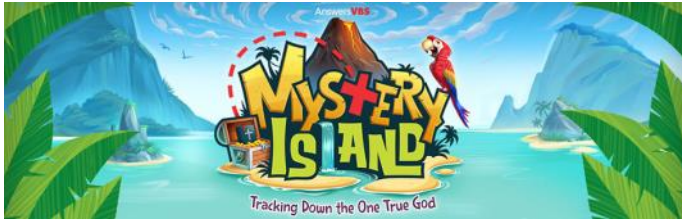

- June 30th Wood Working [4th-6th Grades]

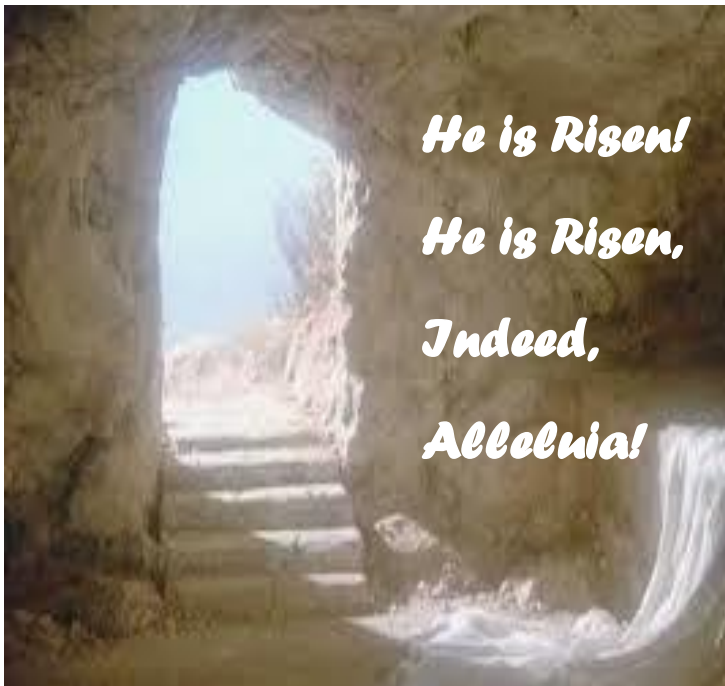
