Grace Endowment Fund

This fund will provide income year after year for projects supporting missions, education, youth, worship, music and capital improvements that help our church run and grow.



Altar Flowers

Altar Flowers are a way we add beauty to the sanctuary for our worship services. Each bouquet can be purchased, "in honor of" or "in memory of" someone. We have two bouquets available each week for \$30 per arrangement. You can purchase altar flowers for a specific date by signing up using the altar flower folder on the Welcome Center. Sign up for the date you would like; indicate one arrangement or two; make a note as to what you want the News & Notes to say; then place your payment in the envelope provided in the secretary's door. The office will handle ordering the flowers.

We hope that we have flowers every week, but we know that there are Sundays when the arrangements have not been spoken for. It is these Sundays when you will not see arrangements on the altar. To assist the church in having arrangements every Sunday there is another way you can help. Donate money to our flower fund. We will then use the money in the flower fund, to cover the cost of flowers when they have not been spoken for. It is important to remember that we can only use the flower fund money when there is a balance in the flower fund account.

In general, each bouquet is \$30 so that is \$60 per week. For the year we would need \$3,120 to cover the cost of all the arrangements.

This year is almost over but we still have dates available in December. The 2025 Altar flower sign-up sheets will be available soon, the cost for the flowers will remain \$30.

MILES OF DIMES - Grace Camp was purchased in 1988. The Miles of Dimes project was started in 1990 as an effort to help pay for the facilities which everyone enjoys. There is a "Miles of Dimes" collection jar located on the Welcome Center. Leave your "dimes" or any donation you may want to make and your donation will be used to benefit the camp facilities.
