Dear Redeemed and Loved Saints of Grace!

I love musicals, shouldn't be too much of a surprise. I love to sing, yet I don't like listening to much music. Nevertheless, I love musicals, especially Rent. I bring this up because as I am writing this, I am singing, "Seasons of Love."

The lyrics are just swimming through my mind, causing my mind to ponder. Parsing every lyric, every stanza, wrestling the deeper meaning. Searching through the unanswerable questions, can these lyrics point me to Jesus? Quite possibly a stretch. Yet, I can't move on. My mind is struck, focusing on "How do you measure a year?"

Many words can be wasted in this article trying to measure five years. How do you measure these five years? Do you measure it in funerals---too many. Baptisms? Weddings? Sermons preached? I don't know the count on any of these, probably someone has kept track. I haven't. One pandemic, hopefully no more of those.

How do you reflect the time? How about in love? Currently I am reflecting on this time in love. Honesty time, I have never been a pastor for five years. Sure, I was ordained in 2016 and technically that means I have been a pastor for eights year now. But the longest I have ever pastored before now was three years. This means new challenges will rise and have risen. Regardless on how we mark this milestone, I want to reflect on this time in love.

Love overlooks all things, but it does so much more. It welcomes, supports, cares, and shares. I am grateful for all these things as I look back. But I also want to look forward to the work Jesus still has instore for us. Which I firmly believe is continuing to share and grow his Kingdom here in De Witt. I want to share the adapted version of my pastor's report from the July Voter's meeting, to help us see the work God has in store for us.

Consider what Paul speaks in Ephesians 4 "to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up."

During the 4th of July parade, I, myself, became a float as I carried Elliott through the streets of De Witt. Walking alongside the Cub Scouts, I had a chance to see many of you lining the streets supporting our community. It made me think of a conversation that I had recently where I was told that Ephesians is like the manual for Christian living. Which I wholeheartedly agree to. It speaks to the whole heart of the Christian. Knowing that our confidence comes through the inheritance received in our baptisms to the armor we wear in Christ. But thrown in the middle is the work of the church. "To equip his people for the works of service." Paul speaks it straight forth what our work is.

The Canopy Café (VBS) workers carried pans of food to and from the Andrew and the Peter retreat centers ovens so we could serve supper!! A repairman was called and it wasn't good news for the oven or the camp. The cost of a new motor was huge with no guarantee that it would fix the problem! SO...the Grace Camp Board voted to replace the convection oven. The new oven has been ordered with the hopes that it will be received and installed by the time you are reading this!! The new oven (with a 5 year warranty) costs \$4800. We are hopeful that all the proceeds from the August pancake breakfast will go towards the oven, but even planning on those funds it does not come close to covering the cost. Any additional contributions to the new oven would be greatly appreciated!!
