Dear Saints of Grace Church,

During the pre-service announcements on June 21st, I announced that guidelines would be coming out during the next couple of days helping us to figure out what the next steps are. Therefore, on July 1st/July 5th services we will begin to implement the next phase of in-person worship.

Seating: Over the last month we have asked that you only sit with your family unit in pews that were sectioned off to help with the physical distancing. While the pews will still be sectioned off, we will be allowing two separate family units to sit together in each sectioned off pews. However, we are still requiring that you maintain a 6-foot physical distance between family units.

Reservations: Beginning in July, there will be no need to make a reservation for the services held in the church. Our current schedule of services held on Sunday and Wednesday will continue. The schedule will be 8 am, and 10 am (camp service) on Sunday, and 7 pm on Wednesday.

Masks: We are still strongly recommending that you wear a mask until you are seated in your pew. Now, we will expand this recommendation that if you cannot be physically distant from the family unit sitting in your pew, then please wear your mask throughout the service.

Social distance: We will be following the CDC recommendations of being 6 feet apart. Also, we are still asking that if you can please continue to go down the stairs near the sanctuary. Still only one family in the elevator.

Offering: Will still be collected in the designated areas at church or at camp.

Bulletins: In July we will have large print bulletins for those who need them. However, we are asking that you please take them home with you. Do not give them back to the elder.

Communion: We will be offering communion during the services starting July 1st. It will be continuous flow; therefore, we will not be kneeling at the rail for the time being. Also, there will be no common cup. The procedures for communion will be as followed. One pew at a time. The elders will be masked and gloved. They will drop/place the host(wafer) in your cupped hands. Then you will grab the blood (wine cup). When taking your wine cup, start on the farthest outer ring of the communion tray, once the farthest ring is empty, then begin on the next row. The elders will help to remind you which cup to grab. If you need assistance, just let the elder know and they will hand you the wine. We know this will take time in getting the cadence down, please be understanding.
