Dear Redeemed and Love Saints of Grace,

It has been a minute since the last time I wrote to you all. Things got disrupted the last two months. But for now, at least in the next few months, things should be normal. I may not be able to say the same thing when August rolls around. But for now, things are at a standstill. Which is great!

Since then, I have been praying that God would give me the next idea. The next thing that we all need to hear. Then it happened. The idea. The situation. It was chaos. It took place Sunday, May 15th, and here is what happened.

If you did not know every Sunday I walk to church, and I tend to walk home. It gives me a few seconds to reflect on the services. How did I like the message? Was I able to explain my thoughts coherently? Did I forget anything? But on this Sunday. My thoughts weren't with the service. It was in a message I got shortly before I left the church. I had sent a brief text message to Emily that I was running late from church and that I wouldn't be home till a little after noon, due to a baptism. As I made my back to my office, checking to see if I got all the lights turned off, all the doors shut, made sure no one left anything behind. I heard the vibrating sound of my phone. I slide my hand into my pocket and saw the message. Elliott threw his new monster jam truck into the gutter. My thoughts raced. Which gutter? Is it safe to crawl on the roof? (Our roof slants in many places). Great, there will be no quiet moments when I walk through door. I snuck quietly into the house drifting upstairs, where I crawled out the appropriate window and saved the monster jam from being forgotten. For a moment dad was the hero. But just a moment.

Sundays are usually pizza Sundays in our house. However, on this day, Pizza Hut was closed. We quickly opened the Casey's app on Emily's phone and ordered pizza. However, many disappointments were beginning to set in. First, my taste buds were eagerly awaiting that first bite of salt that tops the Pizza Hut breadsticks, and second when the Casey's app told us we would need to wait about 40 minutes. Ok, we can do this. We need distractions. Something to occupy our time. A movie, that will work. The opening credits scroll across the screen, the voices get louder. "We want a show! Where's my kindle! No, I want the pink one! Hey, that's my kindle! Can we watch a show! I want Peppa pig...Let me talk! I want Bluey! Dad, give me your phone! Hey Alexa, play Wellerman by Nathan Evans!" Each voice was talking over the next, growing louder and louder before my ears got overwhelmed by the sheer volume that three toddlers can make. The movie could no longer be heard. The chaos was finally broken by a vibration. Pizza was ready. "Kids to the table, please!" "NO, I want to sit here! Let me talk.....Where's my orange juice. I don't like chicken wings. I want to sit here!" Who said what I couldn't tell. The shouting was beginning to hurt

my ears. Kids shouting at parents, and parents trying to get their kids to listen. Voices topping each other. Doing more harm their good.

As I sat at the table trying to focus on my thoughts, I heard myself agree to take the kids to Target. What was I thinking? I was tired. The kids were exhausted. They need to be still. But it didn't stop them from piling into the car. After a couple of quick prayers, I started the car and headed down to Davenport. From the time I can home, to sitting in the car, there was constant questions, but now there was silence. It was welcomed. Until the silence was pierced by a singular statement. "Dad, sorry we didn't listen at lunch." "It is okay bubba, I love you." "Dad?" "Yes, bud." "Can we listen to Nathan Evans." "No. I don't have the right cord....Hey buddy!" "Yes, Daddo?" "You know why I want you to listen?" "Why?...yeah why daddy" Evie finally join in the conversation. "Mom and I love you all so much and we want to protect you and keep you safe. So when we tell you its time for lunch we want you to pause from watching shows and playing with toys to eat something and drink something. So you can keep growing big and strong." "Ok Daddo, we will do better." " I know, it is ok if you forget."

I wish this story ended differently but it is a daily occurrence. Every day three voices try to drown out their parents' voice. Every day their will tries to wear out the will of their parents. But it is through these daily interactions I am constantly reminded of God's gracious love and mercy towards us through my kids.

Because Sunday's interaction with my kids could easily be switched between a conversation between me and God. Me trying to drown out God's voice, speaking over his voice. Not allowing my self to hear His guidance and direction. Doing my best to ignore the places He needs me to be, where He takes us to be renourished and replenished. Trying to keep things busy, keep the noise high, so His voice is lower than mine.

But then I get in a car. Or I stand before his altar. Or I am sitting in the pew. A place of silence. Where's there is no extra place for noise. Gradually the silence gets pierced, not by a singular statement but by presence. Where God comes to meet me. Gradually silence turns to stillness. Stillness overwhelms. A confession is utter "Father in heaven, I am sorry that I have ignored your word. Ignored your presence. Your gifts that you gave me through the Holy Spirit."

A stillness gently turns to peace. God meets me and he speaks directly toward my heart "Eric, I love you, and you are forgiven." Just as in the stillness and quiet places in your life. The conversations that you have with God. When his voice can't be drowned out. He is speaking directly to you, that you are loved and that you are forgiven. That it is okay if you forget tomorrow, for He speaks a familiar refrain. His love and mercy are new every morning. In the service of Jesus.
