Dear Saints of Grace Lutheran Church,

Is there a day that you are looking forward to? Maybe a vacation? A birthday? An anniversary? Something in the next couple of years?

Now why? What is it that makes you look forward to this day? As you think about that question. I will tell you that right now, I am writing this letter on February 18th, 2020, I am looking forward to Saturday, the 22nd. Now there is nothing special about Saturday. As all of this has been swirling around my head, it finally hit me yesterday, "I am trusting thee Lord, Jesus." I just felt like I got hit by a bag of bricks. "I am trusting thee Lord, Jesus." Why is this sentence such a hard thing to live out, trusting Jesus?

When you listen to the words that Jesus speaks, he says so often to give him all of our burdens, our pains, our hurts, and to trust him. To trust that Jesus will guide, that he will lead the event in the direction that it needs to go. But trust is so hard. Time and time again we are told to "just trust me." Only to feel hurt, pain, burdens because the person who spoke those words is not holding up to their end of the bargain. They are not keeping their promises.

But when Jesus says to trust me. When he says hand over all your struggles, hand over your control over what you want to happen and just give it to Jesus. He says that with the backdrop of the cross. He says this with the backdrop of knowing that he came to be the fulfiller of the word his father speaks through him. He says to trust him because of what he has done for you. He says to trust him because he keeps the promises he speaks.

"I am trusting thee Lord, Jesus." These words are not easy to hear for me this week. But they are words that I need to hear. Jesus wants me to trust in him whole heartily. In the good, and the bad. Jesus will hold me through as I trust him to guide through this long week.

I don't know how this week will end. But "I am trusting thee Lord, Jesus" knowing that everything will be ok.
