Item 2.	Fiesta Sports Grant to NEF for AED machines and training – still waiting on the MOU form them before training and installation proceeds. There will be training for 9 people, 3 from each campus who will then be able to go back to their sites, and train others. Information only.	
Item 3.	Plaques for service – no update due to a family emergency at the other end – Touchdown sports Information only	
Item 4.	Finance Committee Meeting – attached to Item 6.	
Item5.	Certificates of Deposit will become available soon, and at that time they will be moved to Flagstar Bank, away from BMO for better interest rates. It was also discussed at Fin. Com. Meeting that it would be nice to take some money from the general fund and round up the amounts being put in the new CDs. 3 options were presented, with Option A being the agreed upon option. 4753.48 will be rounded to 5000.00, 2522.78 will be rounded to 3000.00, and 5653.48 will be rounded to 6000.00. Item 6.	At the Finance Committee meeting it was discussed to apportion a small amount of our budget for unexpected asks from the school beyond the items we typically fund. At that point in the meeting, Dr. Angelou asked if funding some of our archers would fall under that umbrella as they had just earned the right to travel to Florida for the National competition. 10 students are going, Dr. Angelou asked for 300.00 per student, with the District to match those funds. Currently the District is paying for registration fees, and the coaches' travel expenses. Discussion only, no vote –waiting on more information regarding actual numbers and	

	possible other funding sources. No vote on final proposed budget either.	
Item 7.	Teacher surveys - the board would like to send out surveys to the teaching staff asking how we can better serve the teachers, how we can streamline/improve the grant process, etc. Discussion only – no vote.	
Item 8.	Scholarship Committee results – 5 scholarships were awarded to 4 applicants. Mr. McCandlish will present these at the board meeting on May 13 th . He will also reach out to the students to let them know what they won and when to show up.	
Item 9.	Mardi Gras 5K closeout and road map going forward. It was discussed that we would definitely like other groups from other campuses involved so that it becomes truly a district event. Discussion only – tabled due to Mr. Spooner not being available.	
Item 10.	Nadaburg Open Committee Update – In general terms it was quite successful, as always we see small ways to improve the process and the outcome. We’ve asked Mr. Lemasters to ask his colleagues if they would be willing to volunteer next year along with all the other support they offer. – Discussion only – no vote	
Item 11.	It was proposed that we reimburse Holly Diaz for the money she spent on pizza for our student volunteers at the Open, but that discussion was tabled awaiting more information.	
Item 12.	The anonymous donor from last meeting that had proposed gifts of 1000.00 per month has changed their plan for the present. It was suggested that perhaps they could be contacted regarding the funding needed for our archers. Discussion only.	
Item 13.	The American Warehouse Furniture School Rewards Program will be closing as of the beginning of the 2026-2027 school year. Unfortunately with the economy being what it is they felt it was not sustainable. We are grateful for their partnership in the meanwhile. Discussion only – no vote needed.
