Item 1.	NEF has received a grant from Fiesta Sports Foundation for 1 AED and training per campus. Discussion was had on best placement as to augment the ones currently in place on each campus. Training to possibly coincide with a PD. Motion to accept was approved, with further arrangements needing to be firmed up.	KKehoe/BGoodman
Item 2.	Plaques for Dr. Serrano, J. VanAnne, S. Pearson, and H. Taylor are still WIPs, Approximate cost 140.00 each. It was discussed that perhaps we might have a cut-off point at which volunteers would get a nice letter instead, or a certificate. That decision to be made at another time. Information only, no vote required.	
Item 3.	The finance committee discussed having a "rainy day" fund set aside for unexpected expenditures. Once the Golf tournament is complete, this item and several other financial matters will be revisited. Information only, no vote required.	
Item 4.	Applications for our various scholarships had come in, with the deadline being the close of business March 31. We were also contacted by Education for Life/Sun City Thrift Shop with a most generous offer of a \$1000.00 recurring scholarship. No rubric or criteria were stipulated, and it was agreed that we would offer it to a student who did not earn one of our other scholarships. Full title of the scholarship is "The Education for Life Aylward Family Scholarship". Mrs. Goodman passed a printed copy of the email with this information to Mrs. Kehoe to be added to the documents of this meeting. Mrs. Evans will be choosing a partner to assist her in scoring all applications within the next few days. Information only, no vote required. a. Information regarding the JPMMA Scholarship. There were 45 registered archers at the shoot, with a total in attendance of about 80 people. We raised \$958.00 for the scholarship, but this year Mountainside does not have a senior archer. Hoping for more donations next year as this year's income was about half what it was last year. Side note that the NEF is involved in this process only for ease of financial transactions. Information only, no vote required.	
Item5.	Closeout for the Mardi Gras 5K, a copy of that document was handed out to board members. Coach Spooner and Mr. McCandlish will be firming a roadmap for future runs, with ideas to increase participation, and ensure accuracy of course information. NEF will hold all monies from the event (our 20% and Mountainside's 80%) against a future purchase by Mountainside for athletic equipment. Information only, no vote required.	

Item 6.	Open update from Mr. Goodman We have 84 golfers which is technically more than a full course, but are assuming some of the 4somes are going to be given as donations. We have right about \$16,000.00 in income with a net of \$12,600.00 at this time. We are a bit short on volunteers, and Mr. Goodman is going to send out another email asking for help. Basket collection has been pretty bad, but that is normal and they will all show up before the tournament. Information only, no vote required.
