PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – CARRIE ROTHERHAM

- Decreasing student numbers 689 (74 short)
 - All but one classrooms at 23
 - 63 kiddies (down from 100)
 - Cherokee Trail is up; Mammoth Heights is down
 - Copper Steppe Apartments moving to monthly leases
- Board approved Mill/Bond on ballot again this November
 - Carrie has information provided by district
 - Using allowance as examples
 - Maraijuna money goes to district that have lower income
 - Staff is not aloud to speak options, only facts
 - Can not share on PCEA sites because tied directly to the school
 - Can paint car off campus, employees can park in lot with

 - Leaning in this year
 - Being explicit about routines and systems
 - Busses still delayed due to new routes
