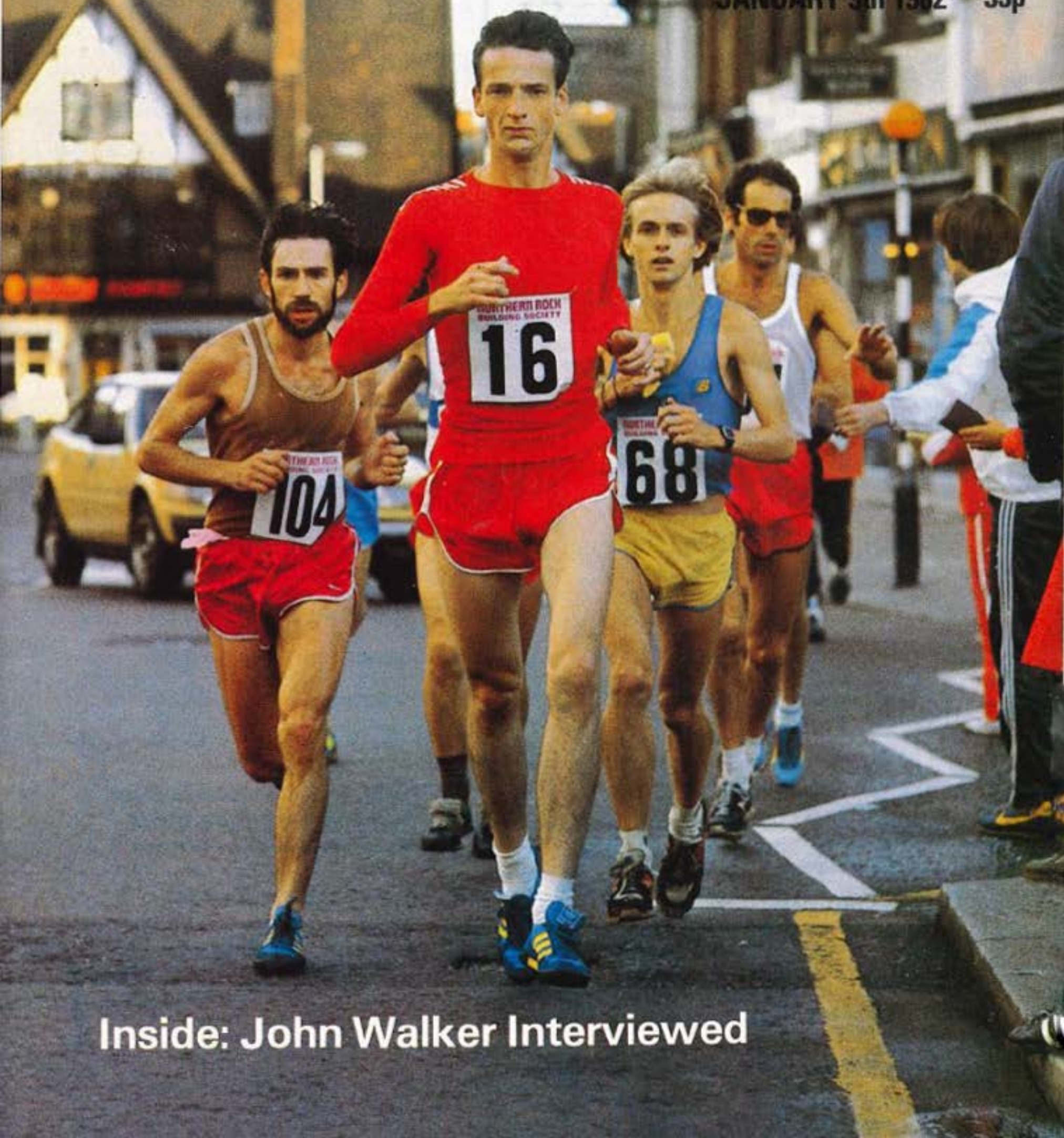

Diana brushed the bar off twice at 1.92 — which was not surprising given the presence close by of Italy's famous Bersaglieri, the brass band that runs — 50 bugles would put anyone off, especially lapping at about 40 sec! All failed at 1.95 and Bienias won the jump-off at 1.92 again.

Gabriella Dorio lined up in the mile against Maricica Puica with Rossella Gramola (Italy) setting the pace in 1:04.99, 2:13.05 and 2:47.69 at the kilometre, Puica was in command at 1200 (3:22.90) with Dorio breathing down her neck. They overlooked Nadyezhda Ralldugina (USSR), who slid away down the back straight and held them all off. Ralldugina, only 5th in the European Indoor 1500, clocked 4:28.46 to break the European best of 4:30.1 by Zamira Zaitseva.

CANADIAN NEWS

A former policeman from Blackpool, Dave Edge (27), is likely to represent Canada in the Commonwealth Games marathon after finishing 11th (2nd Canadian home) in the Montreal international race on May 30th. The winner was Benji Durden (USA) in the good time, considering the high temperature (29°C) and humidity, of 2:13:22, with France's Annick Lebreton improving from 2:42:00 to 2:36:05 to lead the women in.

Edge, who clocked 2:17:13 in this his first marathon, has overcome serious illness. After returning from the Maccabiah Games in Israel last summer (where he was 2nd in the 10,000 and 3rd in the half marathon) it was provisionally diagnosed that he was suffering from a form of cancer known as Hodgkins Disease. He underwent surgery in late November for the removal of a lymph gland — and just three weeks later was back in training!
