NIGERIA's Daniel Effiong ignored strong crosswinds to set the fastest 200m of the year with 20.10.

Not to be outdone, Andre Cason of America took the 100m in 10.01 – the third best time this year.

Cason said: "A world record is possible, but I can't say when."

Jackie Joyner-Kersey won the long jump with a leap of 7.30 but was unable to stop Michelle Freeman taking the 100 hurdles in 12.74.

### USA Athletics Championships, Knoxville, Tennessee, 16th-18th June

**THURSDAY:** DENNIS MITCHELL and Gail Devers won 100m titles on Thursday, the first titles decided in the US Championships. Both races were run into a noticeable headwind and resulted in unspectacular times on a hot, humid day. Devers didn't get a good start, but she ran strongly at the end of her race to hold off Carlette Guidry, 11.12 to 11.15. "I've been cautious this whole national championship meet with my leg," she said, "but I made it through and didn't injure myself."

The men's race was a lengthy affair and it included four recalls before it finally got underway. Mitchell showed his years of experience against the rather young field and was out of the blocks first, never giving up the lead but still feeling a challenge at the end from Jon Drummond, who made it a very close race at the end. The Olympic bronze medalist docked 10.13 to 10.14 for Drummond. Finishing back in sixth was Andre Cason (10.31) who strained his left hamstring about 30m after the start. And not finishing at all was Michael Johnson who was having problems with his right hamstring.

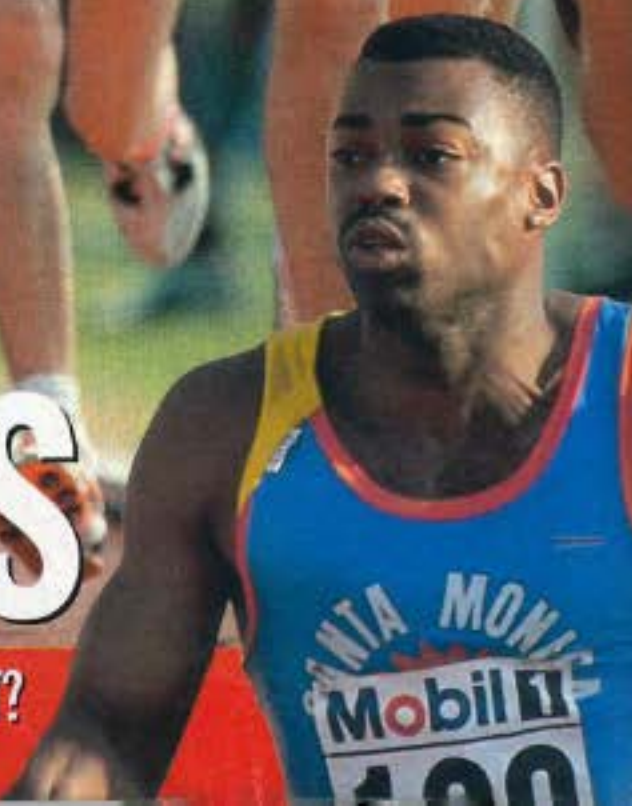
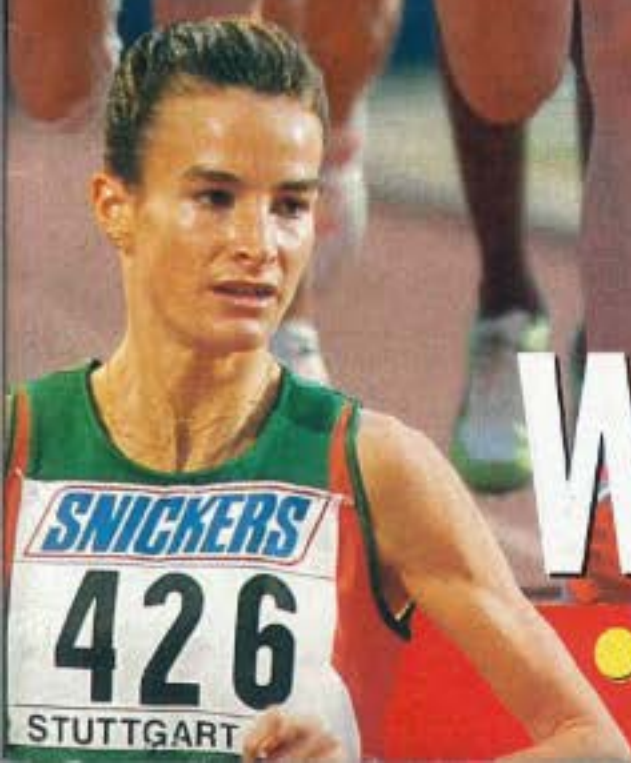

## IAAF Grand Prix, Lausanne, 6th July

ON a perfect evening, Leroy Burrell regained the world 100m record he once held in 1991 with a great closing rush over the last 40 metres. His 9.85 clipped 0.01sec from Carl Lewis' World Champs winning time at Tokyo in 1991 and gave him a big margin over Davidson Ezinwa and Dennis Mitchell (both 9.99).

It also marked the first-ever world record in the 19-year history of Lausanne's Athletissima meeting. "I felt good down the stretch, and then I put it away," says Burrell, addressing the 13,500-strong crowd after meeting organiser Jacky Delapierre embraced him in celebration.

Burrell was not the only speedster on view: Russia's Irina Privalova enjoyed one of the finest ever one-day sprint doubles on record. First, she blasted the 100 field, including Gwen Torrence (10.85) and Merlene Ottey (10.95) in a new European record of 10.77 and then ran away with the 200 in a windy 21.82 (+3.1)...world champion Ottey was so devastated by her 100 defeat that she withdrew from the 200.

Haile Guebre Selassie made a brave bid to add the world 10,000 record to his 5,000 mark of last month, but was slowed by lack of opposition to a second half of 13:43.8, running 27:15.00.

Lausanne also saw the disturbing face of soccer-style terrace hooliganism: Kim Batten was contesting the lead at the eighth flight with Sally Gunnell in the 400H when she was struck in the face by a stadium cushion, thrown from above. Though physically unhurt, that distracted her completely and

she jogged in as Gunnell (54.06) charged home from Deon Hemmings (54.48).

Kareem Strete-Thompson turned back world record holder Mike Powell in the long jump, and Mark McKoy (13.19w) just held off a resurgent Greg Foster in the sprint hurdles. ## UNCAGED ANGER

I SYMPATHISE with Bill Fuller (Letters, 29th June). I have also found that athletic stadiums are rarely interested in mere hammer throwers. We seem to be second class athletes.

Three weeks before the AAA U20 Championships, the Bedford Stadium had the misfortune to have the outer netting of the hammer cage stolen.

It was felt by the management that the remaining net was unsafe to use. The cage was locked up and my athletes were refused the right to throw at a vital stage in the season.

I run an experienced squad, always under supervision, and felt that the single net was enough. Crystal Palace and Birmingham have single nets.

We were forced to travel outside Bedford to throw.

On 29th June the cage had been repaired, but was still locked up.

When we went to throw on

30th June, we were firstly refused permission to use the centre cage as it was "not ready", but were offered the new throwing area outside the arena from a cage that was only half-built!

It emerged the real reason for not letting us use the centre cage was: "We are preparing for the AAA" (which, translated, meant they didn't want to scuff the grass).

After much persuasion, the centre cage was opened up. This has upset the build-up to major championships — Southern Counties, AAA and English Schools — jeopardising the chance of top performances.

**DAVE MARTIN, recovered from the astonishing 10,000m world record, continues his Oslo Grand Prix report**

**S**ONIA O'SULLIVAN failed in her bid to reduce Paula Ivan's five-year-old mile record of 4:15.61 by just a whisker — poor pace making rather than lack of ability being the main reason.

The early pace set by the European Indoor 1,500 champion Ekaterina Podkopseva was probably too fast — the Russian leading O'Sullivan and Yvonne Murray through 400 in 63.0 and 800 in 2:08.2.

With 500 metres remaining O'Sullivan made a long run for home, finishing in 4:17.25, the fifth fastest mile in history. Murray reduced her previous best from 4:23.06 to 4:22.64 as did third placed Regina Jacobs who clocked 4:27.78.

The 800 was a cracker — Wilson Kipketer just holding off the Norwegian revelation of the summer Vebjørn Rodal. Both ignored the crazy 48.6 first lap by David Kiptoo and fought a brilliant battle down the final straight.

Their tussle brought both PBs of 1:43.29 and 1:43.50,

while Johnny Gray also got under 1:44 in third place. Tom McKean finished a disappointing ninth in 1:46.20.

The "Dream Mile" resulted in another World best. There were few famous names in the field as Venuste Niyongabo scored a runaway win in 3:48.94 ahead of fast finishing Abdi Bile with Steve Holman third.

Both Kevin McKay, seventh in 3:53.64, and David Strang, 10th in 3:55.10, set personal bests, although were never in contention for honours.

Gwen Torrence gained revenge over Irina Privalova who beat her in the Stockholm Grand Prix. Her victory in 21.94 was made even sweeter as the Olympic champion became the first woman to run under 22sec this year.

With the wind (+1.9) almost blowing at the maximum permitted, Dennis Mitchell scorched to a 100 metres success in 9.94sec with fellow American Jon Drummond second in 9.99sec.

Colin Jackson was the only British winner of the night. After running a 110 hurdles season's best of 13.20sec in his heat, the Welshman won his final in 13.22sec his second fastest this year.

Indeed it was a British one-two — Tony Jarrett dipping ahead of Olympic champion Mark McKoy for a time of 13.35sec.

Jackson appeared fully recovered from the groin injury which kept him out of the London Grand Prix a week earlier.

Now the World champion and record-holder intends having a busy programme competing in the Goodwill Games, Sestriere, the European Championships, Zurich, Brussels, the Commonwealth Games and Berlin.

If he can repeat his Oslo success in the other "Golden Four" meetings in Zurich, Brussels and Berlin, Jackson will share the \$250,000

## NIKAIA-MOBIL IAAF GRAND PRIX, NICE, 18th JULY

**S**ONIA O'SULLIVAN's record breaking form continued when she set an Irish 1,500m record of 3:59.10, winning a thrilling race.

That was exactly half-a-second quicker than the World silver-medallist ran for the distance almost 12 months ago just along the French coast in Monte Carlo.

In Irish terms it was her third national record in 10 days, complementing the World 2,000m and European 3,000m ones she had already set in Edinburgh and Crystal Palace.

O'Sullivan, who will race over 1,500m in next month's European Championships, once again emphasised her current mastery of World middle distance running.

Placed under pressure by this year's European Indoor champion Yekaterina Podkopayeva, O'Sullivan never panicked when the Russian tried to close on her shoulder over the final lap.

Running with complete confidence she saved her

final blast of speed until the very end accelerating brilliantly off the final bend.

That forceful kick, her last lap took only 62.27sec, was enough to silence Podkopayeva and a field which included many of the top Europeans she expects to tackle in Helsinki.

### FROM DAVID MARTIN IN NICE

Podkopayeva became first veteran woman run duck inside 4min.

Alison Wyeth showed her best form of the summer finishing fifth in 4min 04.19sec ahead of Olympic champion Hassiba Boulmerka of Algeria.

Sally Gunnell lost her first 400 hurdles of the season. Despite the defeat Gunnell insisted that her European Championship preparations are still well on target although surprisingly beaten by Kim Batten.

Gunnell seeking her sixth consecutive 400 hurdles success of the season, was out-sprinted over the final two

hurdles by a delighted Batten who declared afterwards: "I knew I could win it at the eighth hurdle so I just picked up my knees and ran as fast as I could."

Gunnell says: "God knows what happened out there. I lost it between the ninth and tenth hurdles."

"Kim got it right on the night. I'm not disappointed with my run. It shows that everything is going well for the European Champs."

The third World best came in the 3,000m where the Olympic 5,000 silver-medallist Paul Bitok won the sprint to the line shaving 0.34sec off the time set by Noureddine Morceli in Narbonne on 19th June.

Dalton Grant arrived on the Cote D'Azur minus his right high jumping shoe. In the circumstances the Haringey man did well to get over 2.28 for equal sixth place.

Justin Chaston, in ninth place, set a personal best of 8:23.90 in the steeplechase predictably won by Richard Kosgei with another three Kenyans in the first 10.

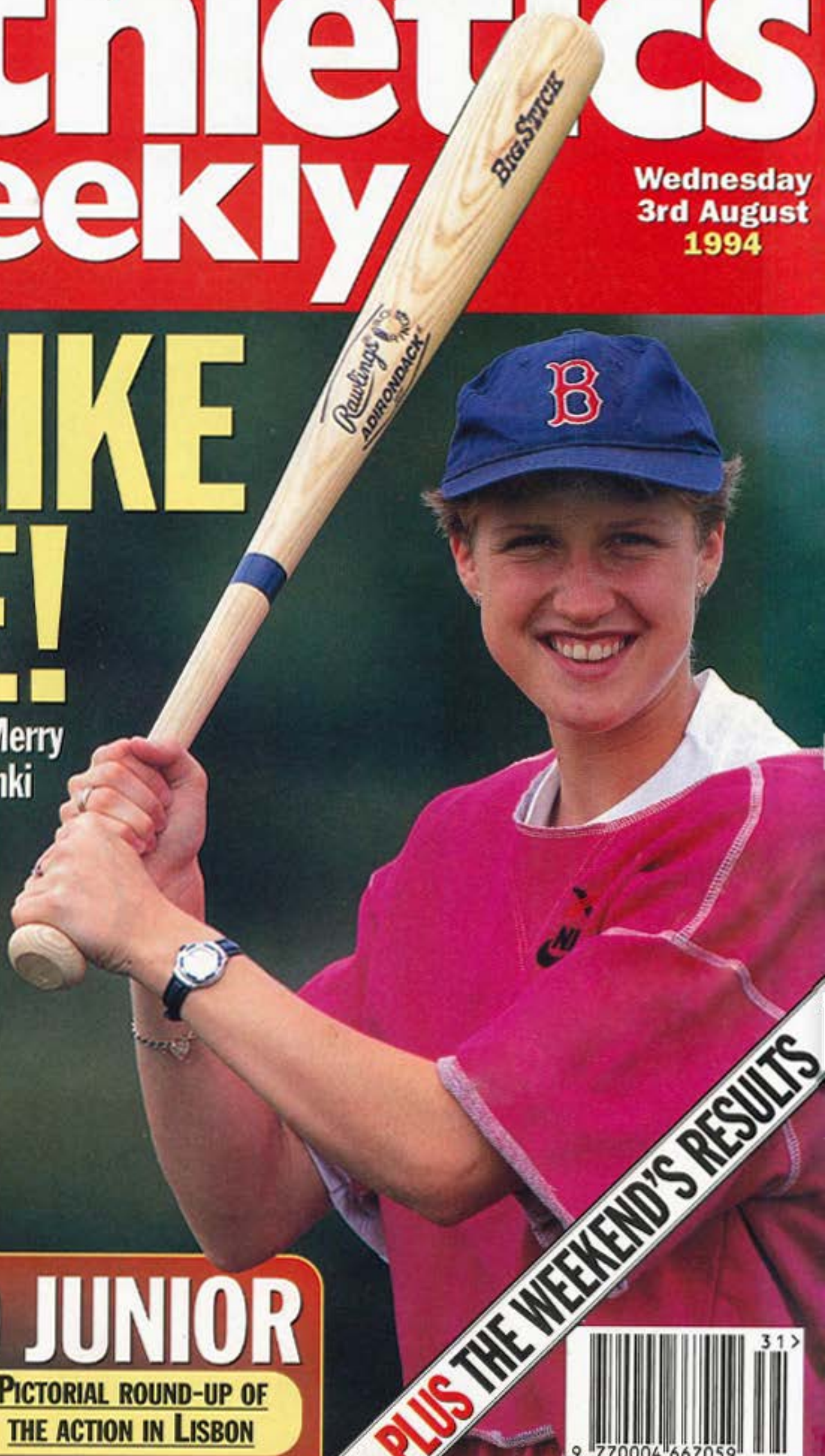

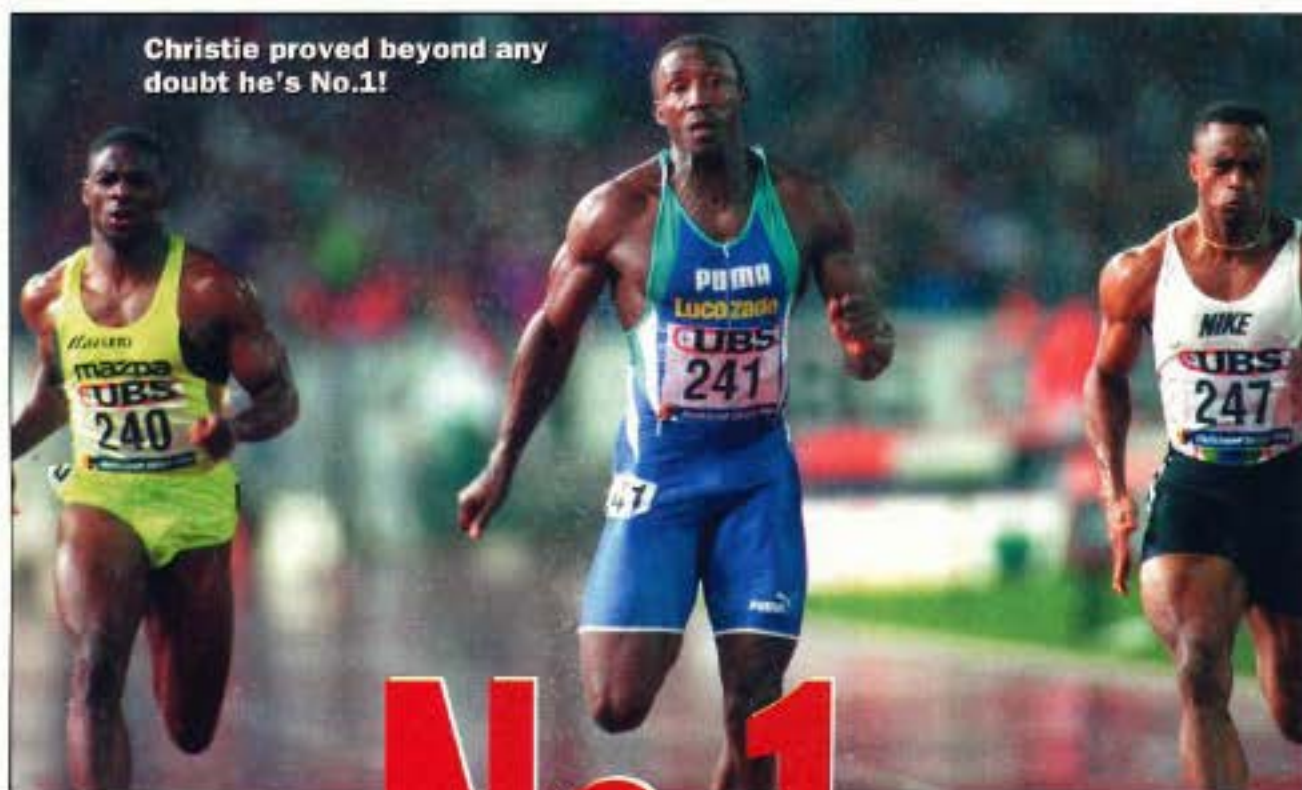


**L**INFORD CHRISTIE proved himself the undisputed No.1 of World sprinting in Zurich.

Even thunder, lightning and torrential rain couldn't stop Britain's Olympic 100 metres champion savouring one of the greatest successes of even his distinguished career.

Facing every top 100 metre man except yesterday's hero Carl Lewis, Christie won by a clear metre from Jon Drummond in 10.05 in atrocious weather conditions.

It was a victory the 34-year-old Londoner had prayed for and he jubilantly declares: "I may be old but I'm not cold. I've proved I'm

the world's undisputed No.1."

Significantly he adds: "After all I've been through this year winning here has given me a great feeling."

Christie then replied to Lewis who has led an American tirade against him since he won the Olympic title two years ago, declaring:

**Zurich once again lived up to its top billing as did a certain Thames Valley sprinter. DAVID MARTIN was there, sheltering somewhere in the stadium, while GRAY MORTIMORE of ALLSPORT got soaked trackside taking the pics.**

"I hope Carl Lewis was watching that tonight."

The pressure on Christie before the race had been frightening after he pulled out of last month's Goodwill Games with a hamstring injury. The taunts from the Americans hadn't helped either.

But he insists: "I expected to win and it's a nice feeling to have done so. Mind you it would have been better if Carl had been here."

Lewis withdrew from the meeting suffering

**AFTER his brilliant win in Zurich, Linford Christie announced he almost quit athletics after winning the European 100 metres gold medal.**

Annoyed at the bad publicity he received after removing his official team vest and donning his sponsors t-shirt, Christie explains: "They made me a scapegoat and you can only take so much of that sort of thing."

"I spent eight or nine years by giving everything to athletics and trying to put the great back into Britain."

"I've won all the major titles and I've always tried to be positive. But this is the sort of thing I get. I don't need it, no one does."

"I seriously thought about calling it a day after the championships."

**AW:** What is the budget for the Weltklasse?

**AB:** This year we are able to spend just over 6 million Swiss Francs (£3million), but at the beginning, in the 70s, our first pay-out was less than 150,000 francs for the whole meet.

**AW:** How did you get into promoting?

**AB:** Reluctantly! I became vice president of the Leichtathletik Club here in Zurich after returning from the States at the end of the 60s. I took the position on the understanding I would have nothing to do.

**AW:** How do you decide the line-up?

We sit down in November and look at the athletes who have performed well in that year's meeting and re-invite those.

Then we start to talk to the managers and agents of others that we are interested in

and by January we have maybe 30 or 40 per cent of the competitors. Then I go

and look at all the various championships like the USA's and then the other Grands

Prix and by August we have 80 per cent of the line-up.

**AW:** In the past there were stories of queues outside hotel rooms until 4am waiting for cash to be paid out of a

briefcase. How is the money distributed to the athletes in 1994?

**AB:** Last year out of 350 there were probably only two who had

no manager and so a lot of the business of handing out cash, starting at 11pm and

taking up to four hours, is in the past.

Money gets paid into bank accounts and by certified

cheques, although Eastern European athletes are still

fond of US dollars. Our biggest sponsor, UBS, a bank-

ing concern here in Switzerland handles these

affairs. We also have a cash machine in the hotel and last

year one of the Kenyans couldn't believe that his

\$3,000 had been counted that quickly by the machine and

he insisted we do it again!

Matthew Yates was sixth in the 1,500 in a time of 3:39.60. Victory went to Venuste Nyongabo in 3:36.15, the Burundian declaring it "a world record run in the rain."

AAA champion Kevin McKay was a lowly 10th in the mile won by Andrey Bulkowski of the Ukraine in 3:55.28. Mark Rowland failed to finish the 3,000 steeplechase and Gary Staines (13:45.57) 13th over 5,000. Jackie Agyepong (13.19) finished third in the 100 hurdles B race.

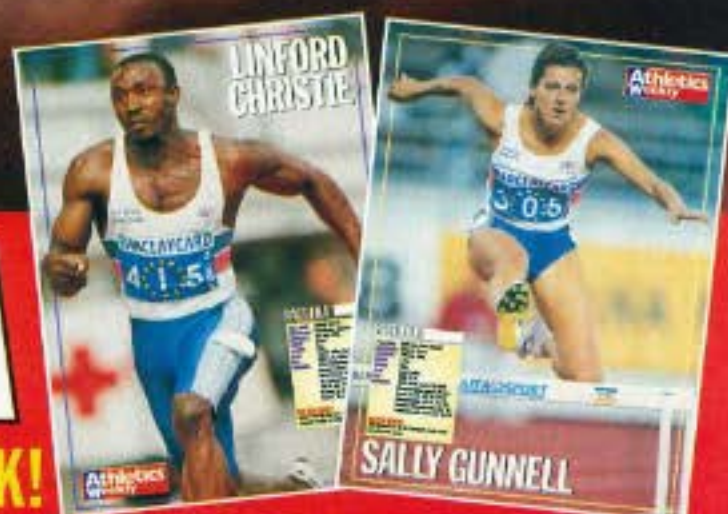

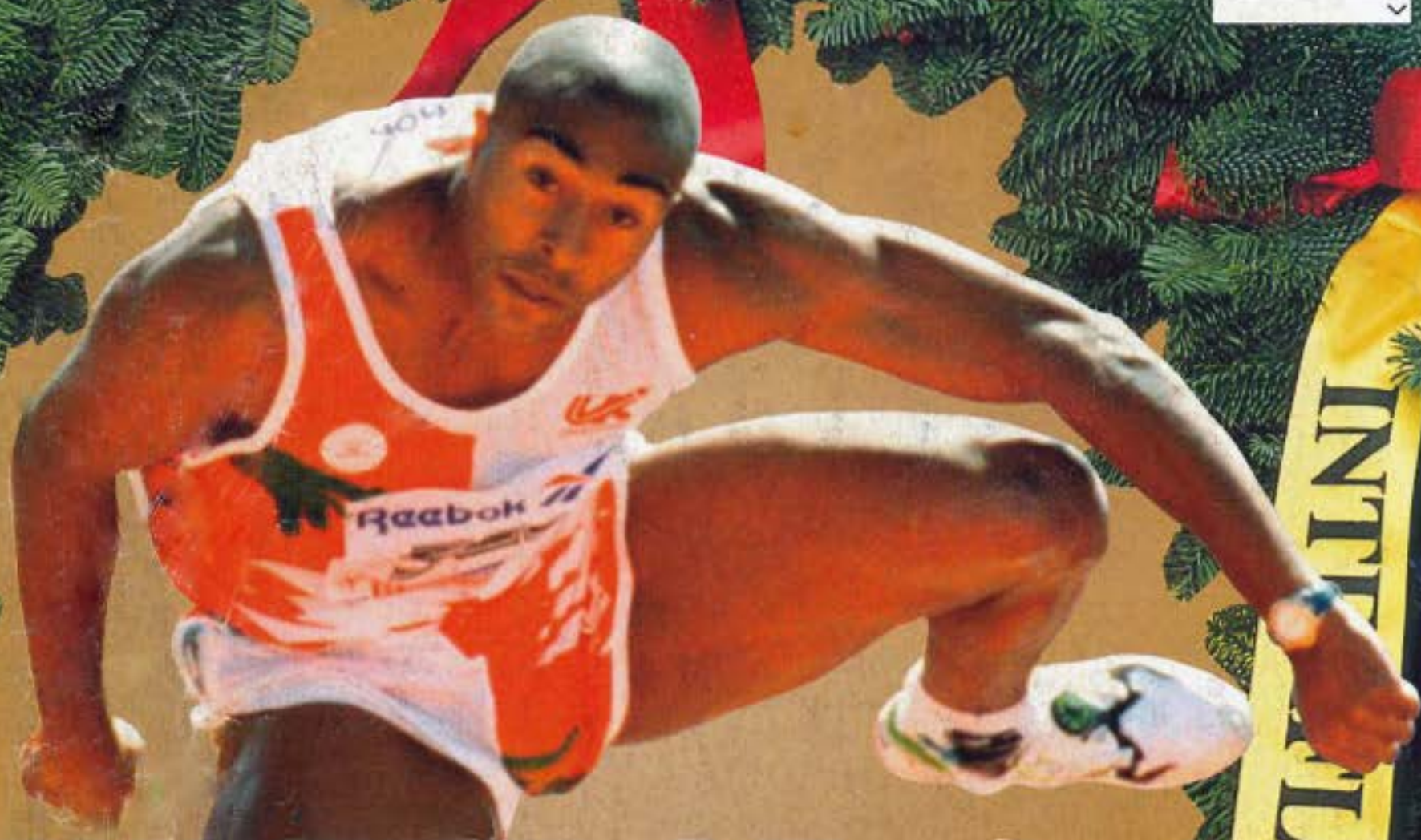

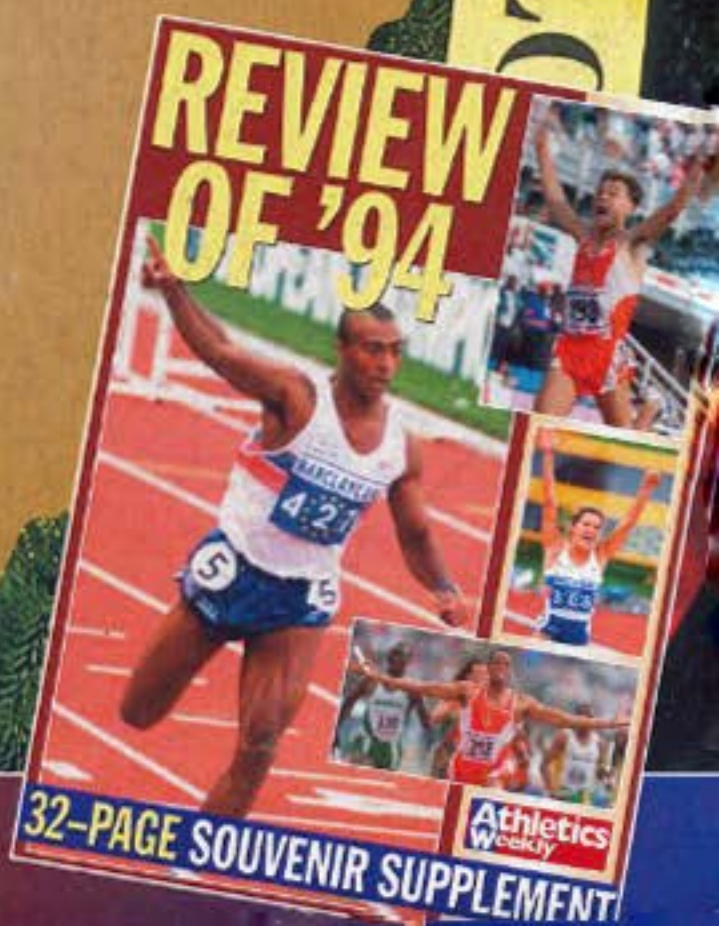
