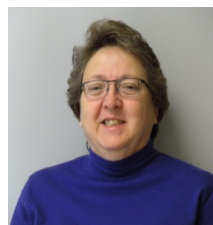

Thanks to the U.S. Conference of Mayors Aging Task Force, numerous mayoral proclamations celebrated Senior Center Week. In 1985, NISC was instrumental in achieving the first Senior Center Week Presidential Proclamation signed by President Ronald Reagan. In 2007, NISC designated the entire month of September as **Senior Center Month** to give centers greater flexibility in scheduling celebratory events.

Fares resumed July 1, 2021. Punch cards and Monthly passes are available to purchase. Call 24 hours in advance when you reserve a spot on Mini Bus. You can sign up for our Mini Bus services by visiting us at the Transit Center to pick up an application or visiting us online at www.FinneyCountyTransit.org.

FCT will continue to take extra precautions to clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces in the vehicles, spraying the vehicles every night with disinfectant. All riders must wear a face covering while in the transit center and riding the buses. Hand sanitizer is also available in the center and on all buses.

Finney County Transit is accepting applications for a Part-Time Driver. Applications are available at the Transit Center located at 1008 N. 11th Street.

TSA Mask Mandate Extended:

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has issued a Security Directive that applies to all Finney County Transit bus service passengers. Starting on February 2nd, 2021, TSA will require individuals to wear a mask at TSA airport screening checkpoints and throughout the commercial and public transportation systems. This requirement will remain effective until January 18th, 2022.


