


























Moving On with Shari:

There is a suggested donation for anyone 60 years of age or older of \$3.50 and a mandatory cost of \$5.75 for someone that is younger than 60. Finney County Transit is a free service through the end of June 2021. Call 24 hours in advance to reserve a spot on Mini Bus or take the fixed route to one of our many destinations for your appointments and shopping needs.

Finney County Transit is accepting applications for a Part-Time Driver. Applications are available at the Transit Center located at 1008 N. 11th Street.

Finney County Transit dispatchers are calling all Mini Bus/Para-Transit riders to update information and to issue out new 2021 Para-Transit Card. If you are a Para-Transit rider and your phone number has changed within this last year, please give us a call as soon as possible to update.

Finney County Transit is taking extra precautions to clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces in the vehicles, also spraying the vehicles every night with disinfectant. All riders must wear a face covering while in the transit center, waiting to board the bus, and while riding the buses. Hand sanitizer is also available in the center and on all buses.
