Terms of Service

These Terms of Service are a binding legal agreement between you and Camp Saugapup/Outback.

Camp Saugapup/Outback is an indoor/outdoor area for Guests to book for their own personal use. We hereby expressly disclaim, and you hereby expressly release Camp Saugapup/Outback from, any and all liability whatsoever for any claims, suits, injuries, loss, harm and/or damages arising from and/or in any way related to your usage of the Camp Saugapup/Outback property. You acknowledge and agree that YOUR USE OF CAMP SAUGAPUP OUTBACK IS AT YOUR SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE RISK.

Camp Saugapup/Outback may not be used for unattended dogs, minors who are booking for themselves, anybody under the influence of drugs or alcohol (including marijuana), and dogs that are not UTD on vaccinations and preventatives (DHPP/titers, Rabies and Heartworm Preventative are REQUIRED and proof of vaccinations must be submitted to info@campsaugapupoutback.com prior to booking). Additionally, all dogs on the premises must be flea-free and parasite-free.

As a Guest, you are responsible for leaving Camp Saugapup/Outback in the condition it was in when you arrived. Poop bags are supplied, and picking up after your pup is a requirement. If not adhered to, Camp Saugapup/Outback can decline future bookings. Please use the outdoor garbage cans for disposal. Clean towels are provided, as well as access to a warm water elevated bath station. The bath station must be rinsed-out after use, and water/propane turned off.

You agree to defend, indemnify and hold Camp Saugapup/Outback harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, losses, expenses, damages and/or liabilities, including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs, that are in any way related to your: (1) breach of these terms; (2) your misstatements, misrepresentations, or violations; (3) property damage or personal injury to you, or third parties caused by your pet or pets in your care. You further agree that you will cooperate with us in the defense of such claims.

I understand the risks inherent in having my dog in a natural, outdoor environment (including but not limited to potential exposure to disease, parasites, standing water and potentially toxic plants, mushrooms, etc. that can be naturally occurring in a pesticide-free wooded area).

I certify that my dog(s) are in good health and current on all vaccinations (we do accept positive titers in lieu of DHPP), are free of fleas & ticks, and are on preventative.
