

## How to Feed Your Cane Corso Puppy

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When feeding a **purely raw diet**, puppies should be fed **two meals per day**, with approximately **1 pound of raw food per feeding**. Some puppies may require slightly more depending on their size, growth rate, and activity level, and it is appropriate to add **an additional half pound** if the puppy is still hungry or looking for more. Adding **goat milk is optional but highly recommended**, as it provides extra hydration, calories, and digestive support during growth. **Iron Dog Raw Supreme Blend** is highly recommended for optimal nutrition and can be found online (promo code **KingsKourt** for 10% off)!

For owners choosing a **half kibble, half raw diet**, it is important that the kibble used is one of the **approved foods listed in the health guarantee**, as feeding unapproved kibble may void the guarantee. Puppies on this diet should be fed **two meals per day**, with **2 cups of kibble and ¼ pound of raw food per feeding**. The raw food should be mixed thoroughly into the kibble to evenly coat it, which improves palatability and encourages consistent eating.

Goat milk may also be added to a half-and-half diet and is encouraged for added nutrients and digestive support. Portions can and should be adjusted based on the puppy's appetite, growth, and body condition. **If your puppy is still hungry, feed more**—a growing Cane Corso should never be kept thin, and steady, healthy growth is always the goal.
