A tartan of our own.*

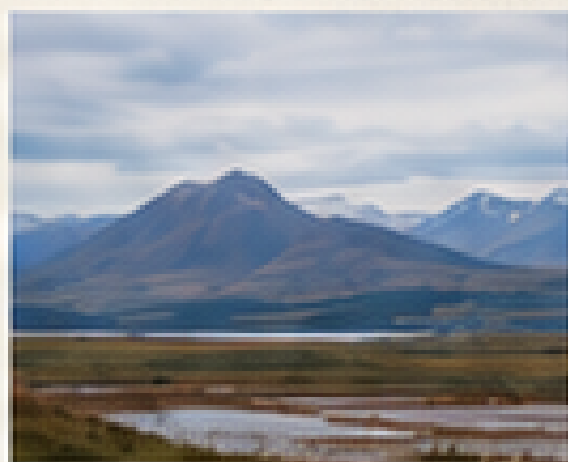


Our Inspiration

The colours within our tartan have been carefully inspired by Knockenhooley Cottage itself, the breathtaking landscape and natural colours of the Isle of Skye, and a subtle yet meaningful nod to the Scottish Borders — bringing together the places, landscapes and Scottish heritage that hold a special place in our hearts.

Designing Our Tartan

We designed the tartan ourselves, carefully considering each colour and the story we wanted it to tell. Our initial design and colour balance evolved through several proofs, refining the shades until it felt just right.

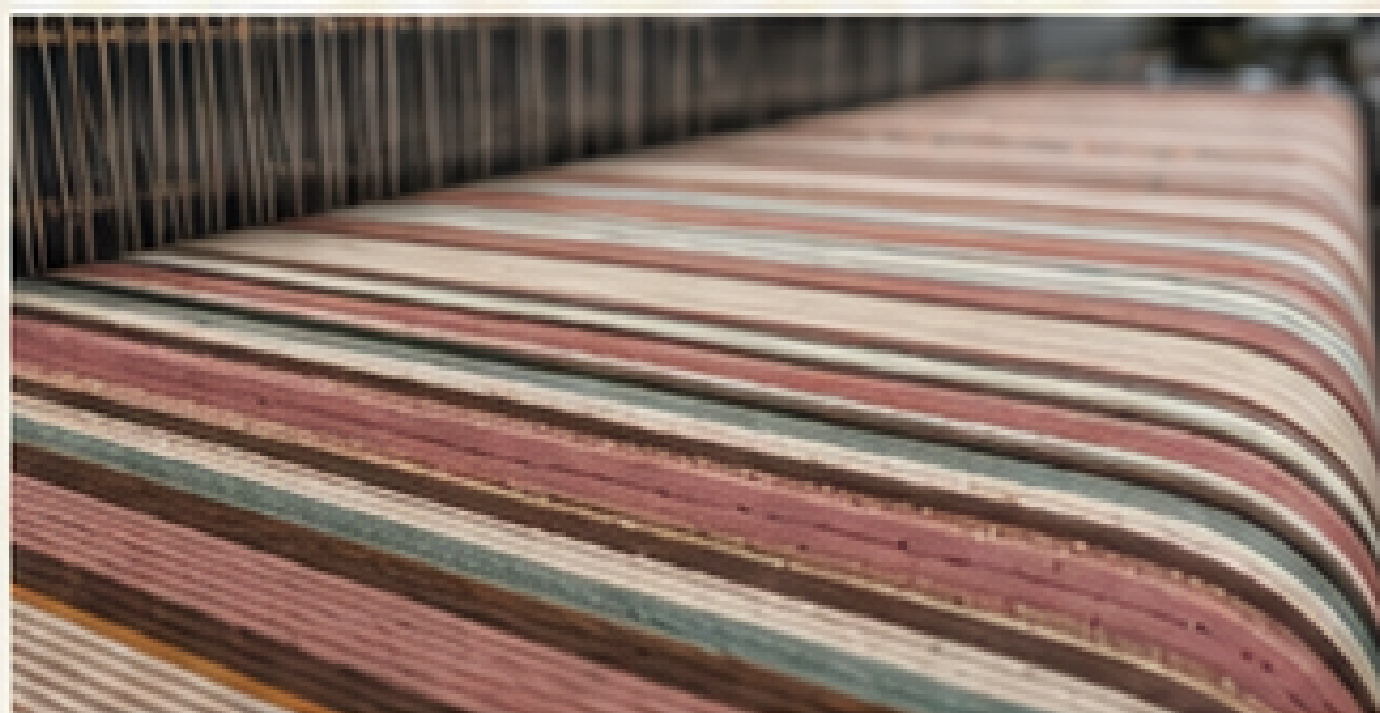
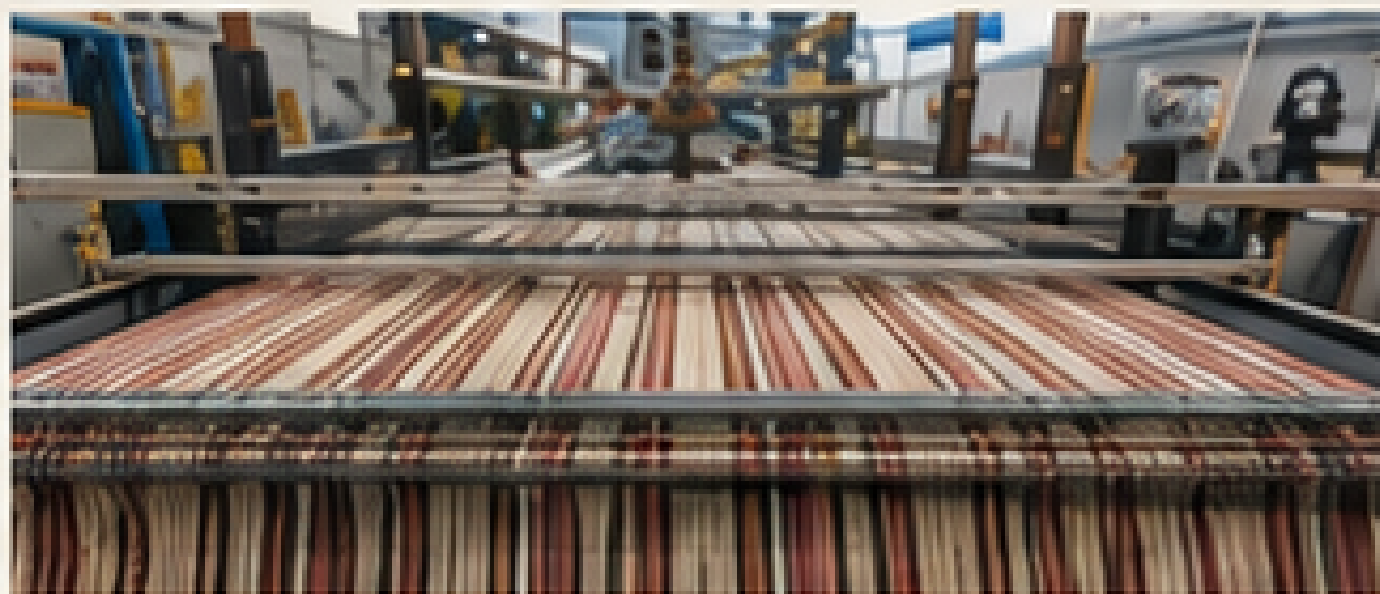
Choosing the Yarns

At Lochcarron we selected each yarn, inspired by the colours of our landscape, home and heritage. From earthy browns and soft greens to gentle pinks and golds, each shade plays its part in our story.



The Weaving

Our design was then brought to life at the Lochcarron mill in Selkirk, where centuries of craftsmanship and expertise turned our carefully chosen yarns into cloth.

Finishing & Registration

Once woven, the cloth was expertly finished at Lochcarron, creating a beautifully soft 100% lambswool tartan.

We are honoured that our tartan is now formally registered in the Scottish Register of Tartans.
