## **BIJAN** – The Boston Immigration Justice Accompaniment Network

If you are detained at ICE, call 617-637-8195.

If you are a family member/friend of someone who is detained, call 617-396-7143 for general help.

BIJAN sends somebody to go with you to court or ICE check-ins. They also provide the names of immigration lawyers, help you raise money for bond or legal fees, assist with letters of support from the community, arrange rides for families to visit loved ones in detention, and help with paperwork or bond payments. They also help with housing, rides, and other immediate needs if you are released on bond and don't have anybody in your community who can help.

A statewide network of legal organizations with a centralized intake and referral system for individuals in Massachusetts facing Immigration Court proceedings. Detained and non-detained individuals from Massachusetts are able to request help and be connected with an available legal service provider for potential representation.
