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How The Evaluation Works:

STEP 1: CONSENT & HISTORY:

After booking the appointment, the patient will need to complete the evaluation consent forms as well as an online intake form, covering demographics and medical history.

STEP 2: MAILED ITEMS:

A packet will be mailed to the patients home, which is used to record responses during some of the tests (with their phone on a supplied tripod so the evaluator can see too).

STEP 3: TECH CHECK

2-3 days before the evaluation, the patient will complete a brief "Tech Check" to ensure that the visit will go smoothly. This can be done by Zoom or by email.

STEP 4: TESTING

On the initial evaluation day, Dr. Moreland, will greet the patient via zoom and conduct a clinical interview, this will be followed by testing with Dr. Moreland's psychometrist.

Phase 1 Testing

All patients complete a 3–4-hour cognitive assessment via Zoom. Some patients will be able to complete all of their assessments during this first phase of testing – however, there is a chance that we will need to complete additional testing in Phase 2.

Phase 2 Testing

Only a minority of patients will be asked to complete an additional 2-3 hours of testing in Phase 2.

Results and Diagnoses

Results and recommendations will be provided to Road To Recovery Neuropsychology, who will then be communicating with your attorney.
