The Chinese lantern challenge is May 2015.

Chinese Lantern Background fabric (light color) Cut 2 strips (A) 9 $\frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$, (C) 4 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$, (B) 4 rectangles 1 $\frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ Lantern fabric (bright color) Cut 2 strips (D) 2 $\frac{1}{2} \times 9 \frac{1}{2}$ Top, middle and bottom of lantern (dark color) Cut 2 strips (E) 5 $\frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$, 1 strip (A) 9 $\frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$

Assembly:

Sew background squares $(2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2})$ to either end of lantern fabric snow ball style along diagonal line press open and trim

excess

leaving ¹/₄"

seam allowance.



Sew the 2 snowballed lantern fabric strips with the long side of the lantern fabric to the top and bottom of the dark center strip of fabric $(9 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2})$

Next sew the $1\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ background pieces to either end of the dark $5\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ fabric. Sew one to the top of the lantern pattern and one to the bottom. Finish by sewing the $1\frac{1}{2} \times 9\frac{1}{2}$ background strips to top of square and one to bottom. The finished size will be $9\frac{1}{2}$ inch square.
