ORANGE PEEL QUILT BLOCK

This pattern will make 1 block. To participate in the exchange, every 2 blocks you make will entitle you to 1 entry in the drawing. This drawing will be held at our May meeting.

Please bring your blocks that evening. The block size will be 9X91/2 finished

Please read all directions first.

You will need: .

- 1 10" square solid white or white on white fabric
- 1 10" square of any print (bright, floral etc.)
- 1 10" squares of fusible web
- 1 orange peel template

Cut the 2 10" squares in half to make four rectangles 5 X 10 inches.

Sew 1 5X10 print to a 5X10 solid. With the remaining white rectangle fabric and the remaining print rectangle fabric you will iron the fusible web and this will be used to make the petals.

Cut out 3 petals from the white and 3 from the print

Fingerpress the rectangle in half and you will place the opposite fabric center petal on this line and will do so for the other side. You will then position the other two petals on each side of the middle petals.

You will then iron the petals in place. Lastly, you will applique the petal pieces raw edge.

I used a small machine sewn blanket stitch for my decorative stitch around the petals.






