What an exciting and emotional time for our membership and our families of Ararat Shrine. Whether you came into the Shrine 50 years ago or last month you will have memories to take with you.

What you are accomplishing today is setting the future and allowing us to enjoy our fraternity without having to raise money to just cover the bills! Now when you work the Circus, Bingo, Sportsman Event, Swap meet, Onion sales etc... You can have fun knowing it's all for you!

After calling 5100 Ararat Drive our home for the past 50 years, we have officially handed it over to its new owners, a church. May 15th was the day we said goodbye to a place filled with countless memories. We have been working for this day for over 8 years, knowing we need to sell the building but not finding the right group to buy. We understand that change can be challenging, but we're excited about the opportunities ahead. All the funds from the sale of the building will be placed into our investment fund! We will now be able to live within our operation budget.

I wouldn't know how to list all of you that have been so instrumental in making this day happen, you know who you are and guess what the bottom line is-it's all of you!!!!

Now that the tears are all over with, let's talk about what we have accomplished! In 1975 we built 5100 Ararat Drive which is 54,000 square feet with about 9000 members. Today we have 1500 members. Our new home at 499 S. 7 Hwy, Blue Springs, MO has 10,000 usable square feet and an additional 5,000 square feet in offsite storage. This move allows us to right-size our building to better meet our current membership needs while preserving our resources. It has about everything we used in 5100, just on a smaller scale. We started remodeling on 5/1/2024. We plan to be in and open by May 23rd with our first events being Bingo and the Ole' Cars Fish Fry. I know Illustrious Potentate Mark and his Divan are planning on a grand opening party to show off our new home, we will let you know of the date so you can plan on being with us for this occasion!

Our new mailing address is PO Box 1930, Blue Springs, MO 64013, and our long-time phone number will remain unchanged. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we navigate this transition and create a space that reflects our pride.

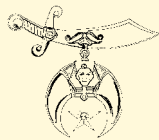

April 2024 Temple Meeting Notes

The April 10th stated meeting of Ararat Shriners was called to order at 7:00 PM in A&B by Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz.

The Potentate called for the reading of demits. The Recorder, Noble Nick Baldi, stated that there are none at this time.

Before the treasurer's report Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz introduced Noble Bob Duncan, a member of the Hospital Transportation unit. He acknowledged the money Noble Bob was able to save on flights by moving them around and saving over \$2,000.

The Potentate called for the Treasurer's report. Noble Weston Miller, Treasurer, gave the report of the current year expenses and balance.

The Potentate then announced there would be a presentation on Ararat's new home with a slide show presentation.

He asked to hold questions until the end of the presentation. Noble Jeremy Yates Chief Rabban thanked everyone for coming this evening. He then went on to explain that they took this challenge very seriously and wanted to take time to introduce and thank the committee that help guide this plan. He then introduced Illustrious Sir Kevin Sleyster, Illustrious Sir Jim Kerns, Noble Roger Smith, Noble Aaron Habben and Recorder, Noble Nick Baldi. Chief Rabban Jermey Yates went on to show slides of what membership has looked like over the years and that the numbers look like in the space needed to accommodate the past Nobility to the current Nobility. He went on to explain the future is bright, but change can always be a challenge. He then went on to give the different scenarios of purchasing and leasing and explained that the Blue Springs location was the best option for Nobility and our future. He introduced the address of Ararat's new home 499 S 7hwy.

The Potentate thanked Divan and committee members for being great stewards of the Nobility. He then gave information on the new location going over offices, meeting spaces, bingo hall along with the lounge area below with 2 bars and kitchens. This will meet our current needs.



The Potentate called for the Treasurer, Noble Weston Miller, to talk about cost savings. Treasurer Weston Miller gave a three-year average of expenses on 5100 location and then presented the projected expenses for the 499 location and showing the savings over the years. He also explained the 2-year lease and the options we will have moving forward. Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz explained we will have events as soon as we get in the new building.

Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz announced we will be open for business at the new location starting May 14th. He stated that bingo will get moved to the new location without missing a week but that will be a work in progress as we move forward. He also explained that we need to get items removed as soon as possible. May 8th will be an open meeting.

Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz announced that the last party at Ararat will be a Mash Bash 4077 style May 11th. He hopes to see all 1,400+ members there to send us off with a bang.

Illustrious Potentate Mark Koontz and Noble Jeremy Yates, Chief Rabban, followed up the presentation with a Q/A session.

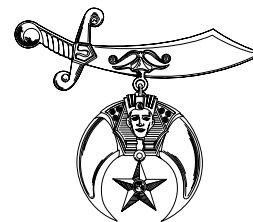
