



Nobles Mike Montgomery and John Foster from Richmond Shrine Club, presented a check to Hospital Transportation and to the 2025 Circus.


Illustrious Potentate Jeremy Yates called for any visiting Nobles. Noble George Thompson, Greeters Director Emeritus, reported that there were none.






