- North State Giving Tuesday Maria continues to explore this on behalf of our chapter. This event provides nonprofit organizations the opportunity to gain exposure and start relationships with new donors, and for the people to raise as much money as possible for participating organizations within a 14 -hour period. North State nonprofits are required to complete a vetting application process to participate so donors know these organizations truly have the community's best interests in mind.
