- Lisa's Email/Microchip Rule: Lisa recently forwarded an email link regarding the new USDF microchip requirement. Beginning December 1, 2025, all horses competing in USEF-licensed or endorsed competitions must be microchipped with a 15-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip, regardless of breed, discipline, or competition level. Please be aware of this rule if you will be competing in USEF competitions.
- **Memorial for Ulrike Fuchs:** A celebration of life for Uli, a long-time trainer in the Redding area, was held on Friday, March 28, 2025. Prior to the chapter meeting, Connie sent an email to members with a link to further information. She also posted details on the chapter's FB page.
