11. Bitless: Classical or Western Dressage test of choice. Horses may be ridden in bitless bridles such as side pulls and bosals.

Fees

Classes: \$15 per class

Office Fee (one time): \$20

Facility Fee (one time): \$15

Entries Close Sunday, September 27, 2026, 5pm



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Ride Times: Available Wednesday, September 30, 2026, via the Pegasus app. Management reserves the right to schedule classes to accommodate riders and the judge as necessary. However, specified ride times will be assigned to each entry.

Horse/Rider Combinations: Horse/Rider combinations are limited to a maximum of three (3) tests for the entirety of the show.

Readers: If you would like a reader for your test, but are not able to provide your own, management will be happy to provide a reader.

Leadline: Leadline classes will be judged and scores provided based on the WDAA Leadline tests.

Entrant Cancellation policy: NO REFUNDS after closing date without a vet/doctor's note. Any refunds will be minus the office fee.

Show Cancellation and Refund Policy: If show management cancels the show due to rain, unsafe footing, hazardous weather, or another unforeseen circumstance, all class entry fees and facility-use fees will be refunded. The office/administration fee is nonrefundable, as administrative services and show preparation will already have been provided. Any payment-processing fee charged by the online entry platform will be handled in accordance with the platform's refund policy. Refunds will be issued to the original method of payment within 30 days of cancellation.

Rain Date: Sunday, October 4, 2026

Fees: Payable at time of entry via the Pegasus app QR code.

Pre-show Open Arena: Competitors are welcome to haul-in to Tri R Ranch and practice their tests in the dressage arena in the two weeks prior to the show. Please contact Tom Richards (510) 755-8452 to arrange your time to avoid conflicts with others. No haul-in fee for first visit, but subsequent visits will be subject to a \$15 fee for each visit to Tri R prior to the show. A 15 minute at a time limit will apply if multiple riders are waiting to practice.

Lunging: A round pen is available onsite. Please be courteous if others are waiting and limit your time to 15 minutes. No lunging in the warmup arena.

Dress: Formal show attire is not required. However, boots and an ASTM-certified helmet are mandatory when mounted. Please show respect for our judge and dress in attire that is clean and neat.

Food: A concessions booth offering drinks, snacks, and box lunches will be available onsite. Pre-ordering box lunches (an option on the entry form) is appreciated!

Dogs: Well behaved dogs on leashes, but please be respectful of riders and spectators. If your dog is a barker, aggressive, an insatiable livestock herder, they should be left home or kept inside your truck. No off-leash dogs are allowed on the show grounds. **There will be no excuses for not picking up after your dog.** If your dog becomes unruly, you will be asked to leave the showgrounds.

Driving and Parking: Out of respect for our neighbors, please do not exceed the posted 10 mph on Two Bar Trail leading into Tri R Ranch and be cautious of oncoming traffic. Speed limit on the ranch is 5 mph. Trailers will park in the open space to the left; spectator vehicles will park to the right near the house.
