55+ What inspired you to pursue journalism in college?

LG When I was in grade school, there was a talent show and I was distraught because I had no talent! All of my classmates seemed to have gifts of all kinds and I couldn't even whistle! I was pouting for days but my mother told me that I did have a talent, "you're a storyteller and you're gonna go in front of that class and tell the best story they've ever heard!" Well that was it. That was the moment I became a journalist. I became a professional storyteller and when Mom got Alzheimer's, she told me, "Now this is your story; go tell it and make it count."

55+ 'Entertainment Tonight' put you in the national spotlight where we all came to love and admire you. How did this come about?

LG I had the time of my life while working on Entertainment Tonight. It allowed me to travel the world, interviewing famous and fascinating people. It was a door that opened because another one slammed shut.

I was working at KCBS in NY, hosting a show that had just been cancelled. Then I heard about this brand new show called 'ET'. I thought to myself, "I can do that." And so I went for it. It started out with a 13 week contract that turned into 16 years.

55+ You went on to host your own show, 'Leeza' for about 6 years and you were nominated for 27 Daytime Emmys and brought home 3. You also earned a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame during this period. How did all of this make you feel?

LG Being the host and executive producer of a show that bears your name is a huge responsibility, not to mention that I had young children (daughter Lexi was 5, Troy was 2 and Nathan was born during the

LG Ese fue el momento de mi vida. Me permitió viajar por el mundo, entrevistando a gente famosa y fascinante. Era una puerta que se abrió porque otra se cerró de golpe. Yo estaba trabajando en KCBS en Nueva York, presentando un programa que acaba de ser cancelado. Luego me enteré de este nuevo espectáculo llamado 'ET'. Me dije a mí mismo: "Yo puedo hacer eso." Y así que me fui para él. Comenzó con un contrato de 13 semanas que se convirtió en 16 años.

55+ Usted condujo su propio programa, "Leeza" por cerca de seis años, y fue nominado a 27 premios Emmy y trajo a casa tres. También ganó una estrella en el Paseo de la Fama de Hollywood durante este período. ¿Cómo la hizo sentir todo esto?

LG Ser la anfitriona y productora ejecutiva de un programa que lleva tu nombre es una gran responsabilidad, por no hablar de que tenía los niños pequeños (Lexi, mi hija, tenía 5 años, Troy tenía 2 y Nathan nació durante el funcionamiento de la demostración). También tuve mi negocio de radio y la compañía de producción, por lo que yo estaba ocupada! Yo estaba en la búsqueda constante del equilibrio, difícil de alcanzar. Grababa entre los horarios de lactancia, el arreglo de mis uñas, mientras me informaba y tenía conexiones en una reunión con los productores... toda esa

run of the show.) I also had my radio business and production company, so I was BUSY! I was in constant search of the elusive balance. I booked taping schedules around breastfeeding schedules, got my nails done while being briefed and had fittings while meeting with producers.....all the usual multi-tasking insanity that I rarely tolerate anymore. I wrote in my new book, 'Take 2; Your Guide to Creating Happy Endings and New Beginnings' that I think Balance is Bogus and looking for it just sets us up for feelings of failure. Now I don't try to balance my time; I think about investing it instead, knowing that some days the scales will be tilted in favor of business and some will be rich in personal life. When I got a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, it was surreal! It's enough to make anyone a believer in dreams coming true. I'm so proud of the work that we did on the LEEZA show..winning Emmys and awards is wonderful, but more than that, I'm honored that I was allowed into the lives and homes of so many people.

55+ Your experience with your Mom having Alzheimer's must have been a terrible time in your life. How did you cope?

LG When the people we love get sick, we often feel powerless to change it. Sometimes we can't change the outcome of a disease; but we can choose how we react or respond. My mom and Granny were the two most important women in my life. Seeing them go through death in slow motion because of Alzheimer's disease is a cruel reality that millions of families face every day. I wanted to pull the covers over my head and pretend it would be better tomorrow. But denial is not a

Cuando llegué a tener una estrella en el Hollywood Walk of Fame, fue surrealista! Es suficiente para creer que los sueños se hacen realidad. Estoy muy orgullosa del trabajo que hicimos en el programa Leeza ... ganar premios Emmy y premios es maravilloso, pero más que eso, me siento honrada de que se me permitió entrar a las vidas y hogares de tantas personas.

55+ Su experiencia con su mamá padeciendo de Alzheimer debe haber sido un mal momento en su vida. ¿Cómo te sientes?

LG Cuando las personas a las que amamos se enferman, nos sentimos impotentes por no poder cambiarlo. A veces no podemos cambiar el resultado de una enfermedad, pero podemos elegir cómo reaccionar o responder. Mi madre y mi abuela eran las dos mujeres más importantes de mi vida. Ver pasar llegar a la muerte en cámara lenta a causa de la enfermedad de Alzheimer es una cruel realidad de que millones de familias se enfrentan cada día. Quería taparme con las sábanas sobre mi cabeza y fingir que sería mejor mañana. Pero la negación no es una estrategia y, finalmente, nombrar y reclamar la nueva realidad es el más poderoso primer

strategy and ultimately naming and claiming your new normal is the most powerful first step anyone can take. It was for me. I tried to match my mother's courage and I always gained my strength from her.

55+ You wrote 'Take Your Oxygen First: Protecting Your Health and Happiness While Caring for a Loved One with Memory Loss,' after your experience with your Mom's illness. Was this a type of release for you?

LG I think it is always helpful to share your knowledge. I found it very cathartic writing about our family's experience. I wanted to honor my mother's desire to use our family's journey to empower others.

55+ Tell us about the Leeza Gibbons Memory Foundation and Leeza's Place?

LG We created Leeza's Place as a safe, supportive oasis for family caregivers. A place where family and friends could go to summon their strength for the long journey ahead. A place we wished we had when our family was facing our battles. At first, our focus was on caregivers for those with neurological diseases like Alzheimer's, Parkinson's and the dementias. A few years ago we included any chronic or terminal disease with Leeza's Care Connection. There is strength in connecting people to resources, to each other and to their inner reserves which will help them not only survive but thrive in their caregiving adventure. I have learned so much from our courageous caregivers and advocates who have taught me how much grace and goodness can come from what appears to be life's ultimate bad hand.

55+ Usted escribió: "Take Your Oxygen First" / "Tomé su oxígeno primero: protegiendo su salud y su felicidad mientras cuida a una persona con pérdida de la memoria," después de su experiencia con la enfermedad de su madre. ¿Era una especie de liberación para usted?

LG Creo que siempre es útil compartir los conocimientos. Me pareció muy bueno honrar a mi madre, escribiendo sobre la experiencia de nuestra familia para capacitar a otros.

55+ Háblanos de la Fundación de Leeza Gibbons y de Leeza's Place?

LG Hemos creado el Leeza's Place como un oasis seguro y de apoyo a los cuidadores familiares. Un lugar donde la familia y amigos pueden ir a convocar sus fuerzas para el largo viaje por delante. Un lugar que nos hubiese gustado tener cuando nuestra familia se enfrentaba a nuestras batallas. Al principio, nuestra atención se centró en los cuidadores de las personas con enfermedades neurológicas como el Alzheimer, el Parkinson y las demencias. Hace unos años se incluyeron algunas enfermedades crónicas o terminales con Leeza's Care Connection. 55+ You are now a best-selling author with your latest book ‘Take 2: Your Guide to Creating Happy Endings and New Beginnings.’ Tell us a little about this book?

LG When my mother got sick, I got divorced, my oldest child left home for college, and I left my job. All of the ways I used to define myself had changed. I knew I had to show up for my life in a new way. I’ve done it and have never looked back. I think life is a series of holding on and letting go. The trick is to know when to do which. Sometimes we need to let go of who we were so we can make room for who we are becoming. It’s easy to fall in love with a former version of ourselves; when we were younger, or thinner, or married, or had a different job. We get stuck there. Maybe it’s time to break up with yourself! That’s what I write about in the book..... How you can create that new version of yourself. Look, you can always hit the reset button and be stronger than ever.

55+ We understand that you believe in ‘The Three S’s.....Sleep, Share and Speak Out.’ Could you

A veces tenemos que dejar de lado lo que fuimos para que podamos dar cabida a quien nos estamos convirtiendo. Es fácil enamorarse de una antigua versión de nosotros mismos, y cuando éramos más jóvenes, o más delgado, o casada, o tuvo un trabajo diferente. Nos quedamos atrapados allí. Tal vez es hora de romper con usted mismo! Eso es lo que escribo en el libro... ¿Cómo se puede crear esa nueva versión de sí mismo? Siempre se puede pulsar el botón de reinicio y ser más fuerte que nunca.

55+ Entendemos que usted cree en: Dormir, Compartir y Comunicar. Podría ampliar esto para nosotros?

LG He investigado como proviene el estrés y trato de encontrar métodos sencillos que funcionan. DORMIR.... Si no duerme, se agota. Es tan simple como eso. No podemos afrontar nada si estamos crónicamente funcionando en vacío. El cuerpo y el cerebro envejecen y pueden ponerlo en riesgo de un gran número de afecciones y enfermedades.

LG I have looked at stress management and tried to find simple approaches that work. This is one of them.... The Three S's.

SLEEP... If you don't sleep, you deplete. It's as simple as that. We can't cope if we are chronically running on empty. It ages your body and your brain and can put you at risk for a multitude of conditions and diseases. **SHARE.....** Now this one is simple enough. It's not usually the load that kills us, it's how we carry it....and many of us (women especially) insist on trying to do it all alone! Asking for help is a survival tactic of successful people I have studied over time. **SPEAK OUT....** Few things are more dangerous than a belief or passion that goes unspoken. If you care about something and suppress it, that festers and manifests in ways that are not so pretty. Silencing your voice makes you angry and bitter. If there are people in your life who cause you to feel meek or small and don't allow you to speak out, this is a red flag. Those people are toxic to your emotional, physical and spiritual health. Loyalty is a lovely thing, but not when it's killing you. So edit these people out of your life.

If you start treating yourself better in these three areas, I promise you'll begin to see results in your life.

55+ What kind of issues are you dealing with in your current projects, 'America Now' and 'My Generation?' Where do you see them going in the future?

LG This is the perfect show for me because it's all about empowering people; making them smarter, stronger, safer and more resourceful in their own lives. Bill Rancic, (from E!'s "Giuliana & Bill") and I co-host

Si hay gente en tu vida que te hacen sentir humilde y pequeña y no te permiten hablar, esto es una señal de alerta. Esas personas son tóxicas para tu salud emocional, física y espiritual. La lealtad es una cosa hermosa, pero no cuando te está matando. Así que saca esta gente de tu vida.

Si usted comienza el tratamiento mejorando en estas tres áreas, le prometo que comenzará a ver los resultados en su vida.

55+ ¿Qué temas está tratando en sus proyectos actuales: "América ahora" y "My Generation" ¿Hacia dónde se dirige en el futuro?

LG Este es el espectáculo perfecto para mí, porque se trata de potenciar a las personas, haciéndolas más inteligente, más fuertes, más seguras y con más recursos en sus propias vidas. Bill Rancic, (de E!'s "Giuliana & Bill") y yo co-conducimos el programa nocturno que contiene "noticias que realmente se pueden utilizar." Ya se trate de poner a prueba a tus hijos o de entrenamiento para su perro en su hogar, consejos sobre el robo de identidad o cómo ahorrar en la tienda de segunda mano, lo

55+ You just enjoyed your 56th birthday this year and you look fantastic! What does this number mean to you?

LG I am never again going to be younger than I am at this very moment. That feels great. Every day I celebrate all the things I know, all the things my body can do, all the pain I’ve lived through and all the stories I can tell about it. My husband is 13 years younger than I am. He doesn’t ever see the years between us. We don’t live our lives according to a chronological scale.

We have all adjusted and adapted to what it looks and feels like now to age well.....feeling fit and being fearless and fabulous. Having said that, I think there are few things more pitiful than someone desperately trying to physically hang on to a time that has passed them by with their looks. BUT, it is a crying shame when a young person of 50, 60 or 70 has decided that it’s “too late” or they are “too old” to try something new, to fall in love, to hit the re-set button and make a change. My motto is: Know Where You’re Going and Look Good When You Get There, Baby! •

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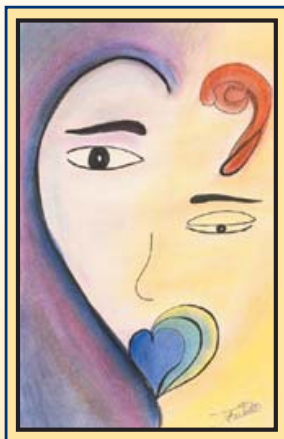

UNDERSTANDING ASSISTED LIVING

ENTENDIENDO VIVIENDAS ASISTIDAS

When Assisted Living Facilities were first created, they were more like a Retirement community. If a person had incontinence issues or required more personal care, they would have to leave the facility and go to a Skilled Nursing Home. Eventually, the government and the healthcare industry worked together to create regulated communities to provide appropriate care in order to meet the needs of each individual.

Once the Assisted Living Facilities were established, the need for other types of alternative housing came to light such as Independent Living, Adult Family Care Homes and Alzheimer-Dementia Units. In Florida, small, six bed facilities (private homes) are gaining popularity due to the fact that they can provide even more personalized care. They are licensed and regulated by the same agencies that govern all of the Assisted Living Facilities, regardless of size.

Many people do not completely understand the concept of, or what is actually offered in an Assisted Living Facility (ALF).

A prospective candidate for an ALF is usually in need of at least one or more Activities of Daily Living (ADLs). Some of the ADLs are showering, dressing, toileting and medication management. The staff of an ALF is trained to provide assistance with all of those ADLs along with housekeeping, laundry, transportation and social activities.

Most facilities are paid for by private, "out of pocket" funds.

Cuando las viviendas asistidas se crearon por primera vez, era como una comunidad de jubilados. Si una persona tenía problemas de incontinencia o requería una atención más personal, tenían que abandonar el centro e ir a un sanatorio. Finalmente, el gobierno y la industria de la salud trabajaron juntos para crear comunidades reguladas para proporcionar la atención adecuada con el fin de satisfacer las necesidades de cada individuo.

Una vez que las instalaciones de viviendas asistidas se establecieron, la necesidad de otro tipo de alojamiento alternativo salieron a la luz, tales como centros Independiente, Hogares de Cuidado Familiar y Unidades de Demencias. En la Florida, las instalaciones pequeñas, (casas particulares) están ganando popularidad debido al hecho de que puedan brindar atención más personalizada. Ellos están autorizadas y reguladas por los mismos organismos que rigen todas las instalaciones de vida asistida, independientemente de su tamaño.

Muchas personas no comprenden el concepto de, o lo que está siendo ofrecido en una instalación de vida asistida (ALF).

Un posible candidato es por lo general cuando la persona necesita asistencia por lo menos en una o más actividades de la vida diaria (AVD). COMENTARIOS DEL SHERIFF

SHERIFF SCOTT J. ISRAEL BROWARD COUNTY, FL



An approaching hurricane can often leave people in a last minute frenzy to prepare for the storm. The Broward Sheriff's Office works year round with our local, state and federal partners to ensure the effectiveness of our emergency response during a hurricane. Just as we at BSO plan for unexpected weather emergencies, so should you. As we enter hurricane season, I strongly encourage you to be proactive. Create a disaster supply kit and have an emergency plan in place for you and your family.

When preparing your disaster supply kit, the rule of thumb is "hope for three, plan for seven." Ask yourself what you would need if you couldn't get to a grocery store, pharmacy, bank or gas station for several days. Some items to include are:

- one gallon of water per person per day
- non-perishable food items
- a can opener
- specialty food items for infants, elderly or pets
- blankets and pillows
- rain gear
- comfortable, sturdy shoes
- a seven-day supply of medicines or prescription drugs
- first aid items
- flashlights and an ample supply of batteries
- a battery-operated radio
- a fully-charged cell phone
- cash and credit cards
- a full tank of gas
- a waterproof container filled with important documents.

Stay Safe!

Un huracán que se aproxima a menudo puede dejar a las personas en un frenesí de última hora para prepararse para la tormenta. La Oficina del Sheriff de Broward trabaja todo el año con nuestros socios locales, estatales y federales para garantizar la eficacia de nuestra respuesta de emergencia durante un huracán. Del mismo modo que BSO planea para emergencias climáticas inesperadas, usted debería hacer lo mismo. Al entrar en la temporada de huracanes, yo recomiendo que sea proactivo. Crear un equipo de suministros para casos de desastre y tener un plan de emergencia para usted y su familia.

En la preparación de su equipo de suministros para desastres, la regla de oro es "la esperanza para tres, plan de siete." Pregúntate a ti mismo lo que se necesita si no puede llegar a una tienda, farmacia, banco o estación de servicio durante varios días. Algunos elementos a incluir son:

- un galón de agua por persona por día
- alimentos no perecederos
- un abrelatas
- los alimentos especiales para bebés, ancianos o mascotas
- mantas y almohadas
- equipo para la lluvia
- zapatos cómodos y resistentes
- un suministro de siete días de medicamentos o medicamentos recetados
- los elementos de primeros auxilios
- linternas y una amplia variedad de baterías
- una radio de pilas
- un teléfono móvil completamente cargado
- dinero en efectivo y tarjetas de crédito
- el tanque lleno de gasolina
- un recipiente a prueba de agua repleto de documentos importantes.

HOW DO I GET MEDICAID TO PAY FOR MY SERVICES?

Medicaid helps give financial assistance to those who qualify based on their medical and financial situation.

A person must meet financial, medical and residential requirements in order to receive benefits.

The Medicaid program has very strict guidelines. With knowledgeable, professional assistance, you will find that income and assets can be restructured in order to protect the patient and/or family. In so doing, this can give the patient a better quality of life.

The Long-Term Care Diversion Program and the Medicaid Waiver Program in Florida are two programs that help people avoid going to a nursing home. Instead, through these programs, a person can remain in their home or go to an Assisted Living Facility.

Note that Medicaid does not pay the whole cost of care. This is based on his/her income.

Scoop for Seniors can assist you in understanding these very specific programs and help you receive the services that you are entitled to. For more information about these services and programs, call a Transitional Coordinator at (954) 961-5223. A Medicaid Specialist can guide you through the Medicaid Program. •

The Veteran's benefit is designed to provide financial assistance to help cover the cost of long term care in the home, in an Assisted Living Facility or in a Skilled Nursing Home.

The benefit is for Veterans and surviving spouses who require a caregiver in at least two of the Activities of Daily Living (ADLs). Some of those ADLs are dressing, bathing, cooking, eating, grooming, transportation, etc.

This benefit is called Aid and Attendance and a Veteran or a surviving spouse never has to pay it back or pay taxes on it.

There are certain requirements that one has to meet in order to receive this benefit. Some of them are:

1. Must have served at least 90 days of active duty and one of those days must be during war time.
2. Must have anything other than a dishonorable discharge.
3. Surviving spouse must have been married to a Veteran at the time of his/her passing.
4. Must need assistance with at least two ADLs.
5. Must meet income and asset criteria required by the VA.
6. Must be at least 65 years old or totally disabled.

El beneficio de los Veteranos está diseñado para dar asistencia financiera y cubrir el costo de la atención personal en el hogar, en un centro de asistencia o en un centro especializado.

El beneficio es para los veteranos y cónyuges sobrevivientes que requieren un cuidador en al menos dos de las Actividades de la Vida Diaria (AVD). Algunos de los AVDs son vestirse, bañarse, cocinar, comer, asearse, transporte, etc

Este beneficio se llama AID. El veterano o el cónyuge sobreviviente no tiene que devolver el dinero o pagar impuestos sobre él.

Existen ciertos requisitos que hay que cumplir para poder recibir este beneficio. Algunos de ellos son:

1. Tiene que haber cumplido por lo menos 90 días de servicio activo y uno de esos días debe ser durante el tiempo de guerra.
2. Debe tener algo más que una baja deshonrosa.
3. El Cónyuge sobreviviente deberá haber estado casado en el momento de su fallecimiento.
4. Debe necesitar ayuda con al menos dos AVD.
5. Debe cumplir con los requisitos de ingresos y bienes por la VA.
6. Debe tener por lo menos 65 años de edad o incapacitado totalmente.

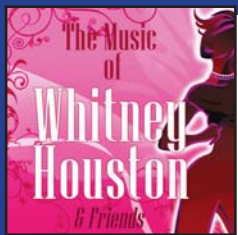

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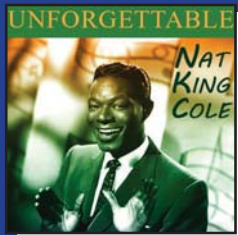

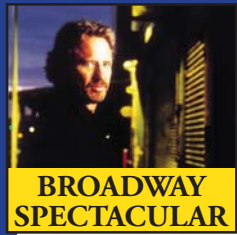
