

Beyond performing, Emily is passionate about nurturing the next generation of musicians through Yorkshire Violinist, which encompasses her instrumental tuition services. With nearly 20 years of teaching experience in state and private schools, music services, and individual lessons, she offers tailored guidance in violin, viola, piano, and music theory to students of all levels.

Away from her music, Emily loves exploring the Yorkshire countryside as a keen hiker, finding inspiration in its stunning landscapes. She shares her life and love of music with her husband Paul, also a professional musician, and their three children: Charlie, Sam, and Erin.

IF YOU WOULD LIKE A SPECIFIC SONG FOR YOUR PRE-CEREMONY, DRINKS RECEPTION OR WEDDING BREAKFAST SETS AND IT IS NOT CURRENTLY ON THE REPERTOIRE LIST THEN JUST ASK; I MAY HAVE IT, OR IF NOT IT CAN BE ADDED FOR A SMALL EXTRA FEE.



Q: Can you perform outside?

A: Yes, in many cases. Be sure to have a backup plan in case of questionable weather as violins and the associated electrical equipment cannot be played in rain or direct sunlight. Please consider what protection there might be at your venue for shade in sunny weather or shelter for inclement weather.

Q: What should I provide for the musician(s)?

A: Logistics/Equipment: For solo violin, much of the equipment is provided by the musician. A plug socket would be useful for longer bookings (2 hours+) for the PA system / iPad, etc. For ensemble bookings, see below. Suitable space for performers is required - please discuss this during the booking process. Food/Refreshments: For longer bookings, such as the Platinum Package, please advise whether food/drink is provided for your suppliers, so the musician(s) know to bring their own refreshments or not. It is usually good practice to provide some sort of refreshments for the musician(s) for Gold Package bookings, but again, if this is not possible please advise prior to the big day so musicians can plan ahead.

Q: Do you take piece/song requests?

A: YES - for the ceremony: Typically, there are five piece/song requests taken per wedding to cover the key moments in the ceremony (entrance/signing the register/exit) plus one during the pre-ceremony set (and wedding breakfast entrance if booking the Platinum Package).

Other music is chosen from already-rehearsed music which matches your desired atmosphere, specified during the planning process. You can also specify pieces/songs that you do **not** want the musician to play. Additional extra pieces/songs can be prepared for an extra fee upon request.

Q: What equipment do you use?

[All equipment is supplied by the musicians unless otherwise stated]

A: Solo Violin/Cello: Violin/Cello, music stand, portable battery-operated PA system.

Violin & Cello Duo/Violin & Flute Duo/Violin & Guitar Duo / Violin & Harp Duo / String Trio/String Quartet: instruments, music stand, a chair per player.

Violin & Piano Duo: violin, piano, piano stand, PA system, music stand.

Violin & Harp: needs level ground and easy access to venue due to instrument size.

Q: Does the quotation include travel costs?

A: Yes, where your venue is within 1 hour of HD3 3**.

Further journeys: 1-1.5 hours £20 / 1.5-2hrs £25 / 2-2.5hrs £30 / 2.5-3hrs £35 / 3-3.5hrs £40 / 3.5-4hrs £45 / 4hrs+ £50 plus accommodation costs covered. Ensemble musicians will aim to car-share wherever possible.

Q: How long does it take you to set up?

A: For the most part, musicians arrive at least hour before the ceremony start time to set up, sound check where needed and to ensure everything is ready to go.

Q: Are you insured & is your equipment PAT tested?

A: Absolutely. The PLI and PAT certificates can be provided upon request. Musicians used in YV ensembles are also insured and using PAT tested equipment.

HOW DO I BOOK?

Confirm Your 'Order': Complete the Booking Confirmation form by clicking on the link below. This form allows you to clarify essential event details and confirm the details of your 'order'. Please fill in the known details, and do not worry if some sections remain blank (music choices are not needed upon booking or until two months before the big day!)

Confirm Booking Contract: Your finalised Booking Contract will be prepared for your review. Upon confirming the Terms and Conditions online, you will then receive the Deposit Invoice email, including the invoice and payment information.

Payment Schedule: A nonrefundable Booking Deposit of £100 secures your chosen date. No further payments are necessary until the final balance, which is due two weeks before your event. An email reminder containing the final balance invoice will be sent three weeks before your event date.




Bookings are only secured upon receipt of the Booking Deposit
