**Saint John, NB** - April 5, 2024 - After a hiatus brought on by the global pandemic, Fort Heart Productions is proud to announce its return as it relaunches in the vibrant arts scene of Saint John, New Brunswick. Founded in Vancouver in 2017 by Mariel Kathryn Hunter, Fort Heart Productions quickly made a name for itself, producing 20 shows and theatrical pieces alongside numerous community-building events and skill-focused workshops before the pandemic forced a pause in operations in 2020.

Now, with Hunter's return to her hometown of Saint John, Fort Heart Productions is poised for a triumphant resurgence. Hunter, an accomplished playwright, director, and performer, brings with her a wealth of experience and a passion for creating compelling and thought-provoking theatrical experiences.

As part of the company's re-launch, Fort Heart Productions will be hosting a free acting workshop on May 4th, 2024, providing an opportunity for members of the local thespian community to work with Hunter and learn more about her vision for the company's future. The workshop will serve as an introduction to Fort Heart Productions' mission of fostering creativity, collaboration, and artistic excellence within the Saint John community.

"I am thrilled to be bringing Fort Heart Productions back to my hometown of Saint John," said Mariel Kathryn Hunter, Founder and Artistic Director of Fort Heart Productions. "Saint John's arts community is flourishing, and I am excited to contribute to its growth and vitality. The goal was always to be able to bring my professional experience from Vancouver to play a part in the expansion of the arts in Saint John and I'm elated to finally have that opportunity."

Following the introductory workshop, Hunter plans to hold auditions and produce Fort Heart Productions' first play in Saint John this summer, marking the beginning of an exciting new chapter for the company.

Hunter is no stranger to the Saint John stage, having last performed in the city in 2017 when she brought her one-woman play "I Want to Come Home" to the Fundy Fringe Festival, where it received acclaim from sold out audiences and earned her a Fan Favourite award. Subsequently, Hunter took her talents to the Halifax Fringe Festival in 2018, where she garnered awards for Best of Fringe, Best New Script, and Best Solo Show.




