2/14/2022 Deputy James Plenty SEARCH OF 2016 HYUNDAI

#### SUMMARY

This is a supplement to a report regarding an officer involved shooting investigation. My involvement with this incident was searching a vehicle that was present on scene during the incident.

#### INITIAL INFORMATION

On Monday, 2/14/2022, I was assigned to work the Crime Scene Unit, 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. I was dressed in civilian attire with the Sheriff's Office identification visible. I was operating squad vehicle 24.

#### INCIDENT INFORMATION

On Monday, 2/14/2022, I had arrived to the Public Safety Building sub-basement and started to continue the search on the 2016 Hyundai vehicle that was positioned in the sub-basement cage. I had unlocked and entered the cage at approximately 8:00 a.m.

I focused my attention to defect B, which was on the driver side of the vehicle above the driver's door. I used an inspection camera in this void area to attempt to locate projectiles. I did drill a hole in this portion of the vehicle that runs down along the windshield towards the bottom portion of the windshield. I had used the inspection camera in this area to attempt to locate a projectile that was believed to be in the vehicle which entered through defect labeled as B.

I was able to locate a piece of gray metal in this channel. The metal did not adhere to a magnet. It is believed by me that this could perhaps be a piece of lead. The fragment was removed from this channel. I observed on one side that the metal was shiny with a silver appearance. On the opposite side, it was a dull color and appeared to have an orange-ish copper appearance to portions of it. The piece of metal was flat and was approximately the size of a large pea.

I collected the item and placed it into a slide box. I had later placed it into evidence, giving it evidence #44698. The item was sealed and placed into evidence storage. I did not locate any other fragments that I believed could have been from a projectile entering at defect B.

I did secure the cage area with the Hyundai vehicle inside. I was the only person working on this vehicle this day.
