Theme: The Wild West - Westward Expansion Era

Bring history to life with your creativity! This year's **History Fair** will celebrate the **Wild West and Westward Expansion**. Children will create **dioramas** that showcase life, people, and events from this exciting time in American history.

₩ho Can Participate?

- Solo Projects Individual children may create their own diorama.
- **Family Projects** Families may work together on one large project. These will be judged in a separate category.

Project Guidelines

- **Diorama Theme:** Must depict the Wild West/Westward Expansion Era.
 - Choices may include:
 - A **scene** from pioneer life or the Oregon Trail
 - A famous person like Annie Oakley, Buffalo Bill Cody, or Wyatt Earp
 - A historic event such as a wagon train journey, a gold rush camp, or a frontier town

• Diorama Container:

- o Shoebox
- Amazon/Walmart shipping box

- o Or a box-style frame made from any material of your choice
- **Identification Note:** Every project must include a note card with:
 - Project Title
 - Child's Name(s)
 - Age(s)

Y Judging & Awards

Age Group Categories:

- Early Elementary (ages 5–8)
- Upper Elementary (ages 9–11)
- Middle School (ages 12–14)
- High School (ages 15–18)
- Family Projects (separate category)

• How Judging Works:

- Each child (or family team) will spend **3–5 minutes** with the judging panel.
- o Children will **explain their diorama** and answer a few questions.
- Projects will be scored using a rubric that measures both the creativity of the diorama and the child's knowledge.
- This means projects are not competing against each other—awards are based on how each project meets the rubric.

Awards:

 Every project will receive a placement ribbon (1st, 2nd, or 3rd place based on rubric scoring). • One **Overall Winner** will be chosen in each age group and in the family category.

Check-In & Location

- Upon arrival at Heritage Explorers Fest, bring your diorama to the Fern Kruger Building.
- Place it on the table marked for your age group or for family projects.

\$ Participation Fee

- \$2 per child or family project
- This fee helps cover the cost of awards and ribbons.

March 1 Interview & Awards Schedule

- Check-in & Interview Times: Assigned at morning project drop-off.
- **Interviews:** 4:00 4:45 pm
- Awards Ceremony: Immediately after the Wild West Play.
 - The play will be hosted adjacent to the judging area, so children can quickly step out for their interviews and return to enjoy the performance.
