Campfire Gathering: Informal campfire gathering in the early evening with Brittany and Justin Sandlin to chat about off grid living and solar power. The gathering time will be announced at the event. No pre-registration required for the campfire gathering.

Night Hike: Gather at Meeting Area A at 8 pm for a night hike/walk with Patrick Maltba. The hike/walk will focus on using your senses and perception in the woods. The hike will take place on Friday and Saturday night only. Adults or adult supervised children age 12 and up only. The hike time will be announced during the event.

Intermediate Slingshot Making and a Fishing Lure making classes will be scheduled in Tent 18 closer to the event date due to the presenter's fluctuating work schedule. These classes will likely take place multiple times in the afternoon on Friday and multiple times before 2 pm on Saturday. These classes are for adults and children either old enough to do the class safely on their own or with a teen or adult helper.

Butchering and Dehydrating Over and Open Flame and Fermenting Classes are walk and stop demonstrations beginning at 1 pm - no need to register for a spot. The afternoon butchering sessions will be focused on the processing of the meat into cuts, and also a bit of preparation and preservation. During reserved hands-on **butchering times**, there is no charge for children who accompany a paid adult. In past years, children have loved to help with the butchering process.

Blacksmithing - Walk, stop, watch, and learn any time throughout the day as the Old School Survival Boot Camp master blacksmith engages in hands-on training with individual make and take session participants. There is no fee or reservation needed to watch the demonstrations and verbally interact with the blacksmith - as much as they are able to do, while hosting make and take sessions.

Woodworking Lathe - you are free to stop by and watch the woodworking demonstrations at any time. Individual make and take sessions will be offered and scheduled at the tent with the presenter. Some projects that will likely be available to make include: honey dippers, rolling pin, dibbler, spinning top, small wooden tree.

HAM Radio - walk, stop, chat, and learn during demos that do not require class registration from 1 pm on each day.

Knife Sheath and Axe Mask Making - You may come to class and watch the demonstrations and learn without signing up for the make and take class.
