



GUARDIAN PROGRAM

As a leader in the security field, Six Point Security LLC developed the Guardian program, a rigorous training program for synagogue security team volunteers. The program facilitates situational awareness, developing tools to identify and respond to suspicious activity, maintaining perimeter control, and practically preventing potentially threatening situations by Security volunteer teams.

The Guardian training program is comprised of more than 20 hours (approx. 10 x 2-HR sessions) of rigorous theoretical, physical, and scenario-based training, with an additional final training session at the trainees' synagogues. It will teach trainees the fundamentals of security, industry best practices, proper mindset, basic combatives, and provide a solid platform from which trainees may continue to develop their skills. Candidates that successfully complete this program may be considered for our additional advanced security training programs.

The Guardian program was designed with the input and endorsement of local leadership, security professionals, and public officials. Volunteer applicants must be vetted and recommended by synagogue security leadership. Applicants must be committed to completing the course. Training is conducted by state and nationally certified instructors and subject Matter experts in the field.
