#### **Your VOTE Counts!**

In the mail, the first week of February, you should receive your Bonita Highlands Homeowners' Association ballot for the Board of Directors. We have three incumbents and three new people running for 5 positions on the board. The previous *Bonita Highlander* had candidate statements from two of the new people.

It is important that you take the time to vote, as we need a quorum to prevent us from having to go through the voting process again. Besides voting for the board, you are also asked to vote on whether the board should apply excess funds at the end of the fiscal year to help offset some of next year's members assessments.

However, the MOST important part of returning your ballot to us, is in the upper left hand corner of the blue envelope. You must print your name and address and then sign (put your signature) on the third line. If any of the three lines are incomplete, your blue envelope will not be opened and your vote will not be counted. Last year, we had to delete five envelopes because some of that mandatory information was missing. This is state law, by the way and not peculiar to your homeowners' association.

Lastly, please mail your completed ballot as soon as possible to ensure that it gets to the Bonita Post Office by March 7th. I will pick up the mail at 10:30 a.m. that day, when the PO boxes are filled. Those will be the mail-in votes that will count.

So what if you miss the mail-in vote timeframe. Well, you may always attend the annual March 7th meeting in person and cast your ballot that way. If we need to change from an in-person meeting to a virtual (Zoom) type meeting, we will arrange for a personal ballot drop-off site for in-person voting.

Thank you, and we hope to see you at our annual meeting.  $\sim Ed$ .

#### From the Financial Officer - 2022-2023

#### Annual Assessment will be \$445.00

Following the third open reading of the budget on January 11, 2022, the Board approved the Budget and Assessment for the next fiscal year. Despite cost increases in certain areas, the savings in other areas helped to offset those increases. In the end, our Board of Directors approved a small increase of .83 cents in the annual assessment a month per unit, or \$10 a month per unit. The new assessment will be \$445.00, due and payable on 1 April, and will be considered as late on 16 April. A courtesy invoice will be mailed to your mailing address of record, which you should receive about March 1st. The Annual Budget Report was sent to all homeowners of record who should receive it around 1 February. Also included in this package will be a summary of our Reserve Funds and a copy of all required announcements of our association's policies, including the collection policy.
