Designated tee time means that all players in the League or Choose-Up with a designated tee time have the right to tee off on their initial hole before players not in that League or Choose-Up tee off on their initial hole.

Preferred tee time does not mean that the #1 tee is closed to all other players. During preferred tee times, if there are no preferred-tee-time players preparing to tee off from the #1 tee and other players can play hole # 1 such that those with the preferred tee time do not have to wait for the players to play their second or subsequent shot, players may tee off from the #1 tee and continue normal play of that round so long as the play of those with preferred tee times is not interrupted by the other players' presence.

Closing the Course The Course Superintendent and the Director of Golf shall jointly make all initial determinations regarding the opening or closing of the golf course or limiting cart use on the course due to adverse weather conditions. If the Course Superintendent and the Director of Golf cannot agree on an initial determination, the determination shall be made by the Greens and Grounds Chairperson in collaboration with the Club President. All persons must respect the final decision. The course will be closed Monday mornings until 11:30 AM for maintenance.

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Membership Types & Policies

Family Golf Membership. Two married Members or two Members who are not married but together are the parents of a child or children are entitled to golf, swim and social privileges. Unmarried children under the age of twenty-three (23), living at the home of either Member are also entitled to golf, swim and social privileges. Each adult Family Golf Member can purchase one (1) voting certificate. This is designated as a Golfing membership.

Golf/Social Membership. A membership category used when only one (1) of the Members described in Section 3.5.1 herein desires golfing privileges. One Member has Family Golf Membership privileges while the other Member has Family Social member privileges. Unmarried children under the age of twenty-three (23), living at the home of one of the Members, are entitled to golf, swim and social privileges. The Golf Member can purchase one (1) voting certificate. This is designated as a Golfing membership.

Single Golf Membership. An unmarried person is entitled to golf, swim and social privileges. Unmarried children under the age of twenty-three (23), living at the home of the Member, are entitled to golf, swim and social privileges if the Single Golf Member pays the dues and monthly minimums equal to those paid by the Golf/Social Membership. One (1) voting certificate can be purchased. This is designated as a Golfing Membership. Married persons may not apply for Single Golf Privileges.

Family Social Membership. Two married Members or two Members who are not married but together are the parents of a child or children are entitled to swim and social privileges. Unmarried children under the age of twenty-three (23), living at the home of one of the Members, are also entitled to swim and social privileges. This membership excludes golf, except as may be determined by the Board of Directors at its discretion. This is designated as a non-Golfing membership.

Single Social Membership. An unmarried person is entitled to swim and social privileges. This membership excludes all golf, except as may be determined by the Board of Directors at its discretion. This is designated as a non-Golfing membership. Married persons may not apply for Single Social Privileges.

New Member Application Acceptance Policy. Persons wanting to become members of the Club must be at least 21 years of age and members of good standing in the community. They must complete an application form, including the Credit Card Authorization, obtain sponsorship from two current Club members in good standing and pay the appropriate initiation fee. Applications will not be considered unless fully completed and until the initiation fee, if any, is received. The Membership Committee will review each application and determine if the applicant(s) should be accepted on a probationary basis. The Committee will send an acceptance or rejection letter to each applicant. The acceptance letter will welcome new members to the Club, explain the probationary membership process and will contain copies of the current Board Policies and any other rules, regulations or promotional materials deemed appropriate. The probationary membership period will last two (2) billing cycles. During this time, new members have full rights to use all Club facilities appropriate to their membership class and must demonstrate their willingness to adhere to Club rules and regulations, including timely payment of their monthly dues and charges. They may not purchase voting certificates during the probationary term. A list of new member names and addresses will be posted on the entry bulletin board for member review and comment. Following completion of the second billing cycle, the Club Board will vote to accept or reject probationary members as full members of the Club. A letter will be sent by the Membership chairperson to inform them of the status change and, when appropriate, offer them the opportunity to become a voting member of the Club.

Initiation Fees, Financial Obligation. All new members have an obligation to pay the full non-refundable initiation fee, if any.

Membership Effective Date. All New members will be billed their normal dues and monthly minimum beginning the month following the month in which they join the Club. Additionally, they will be billed a pro rata share of their normal dues and monthly minimum for the days remaining in the month in which they joined.

Golf Membership Waiting List. When there is a waiting list for Golf Membership, a new applicant must first become a Social member in order to have his/her name placed on the waiting list. The initiation fee paid to become a Social member will be deducted from the golf initiation fee.
