Can you believe that we've already been at Missionary Flights International for one year??

There have been so many things that have happened in one year. God has allowed me to fly 46 flights to Haiti, 11 flights to the Dominican Republic, & 20 flights to the Bahamas; carrying around 498,200 lbs. of cargo and 539 missionaries.

We have taken thousands of Bibles into these countries and get to hear amazing stories from the missionaries of when they give a Bible to someone who doesn't have one.

We took a team of eye doctors and nurses into Haiti to do eye surgeries. People who were blind and couldn't see came and had a quick 15-20 min. surgery and it gave them back their sight. They were able to see again!

We took a team of doctors in that were going around the town. They found a little girl whose flesh was wounded and torn open around her leg from a tree falling on it. A simple antibacterial formula and several stitches saved the girl from getting an infection and them having to amputate her leg.
