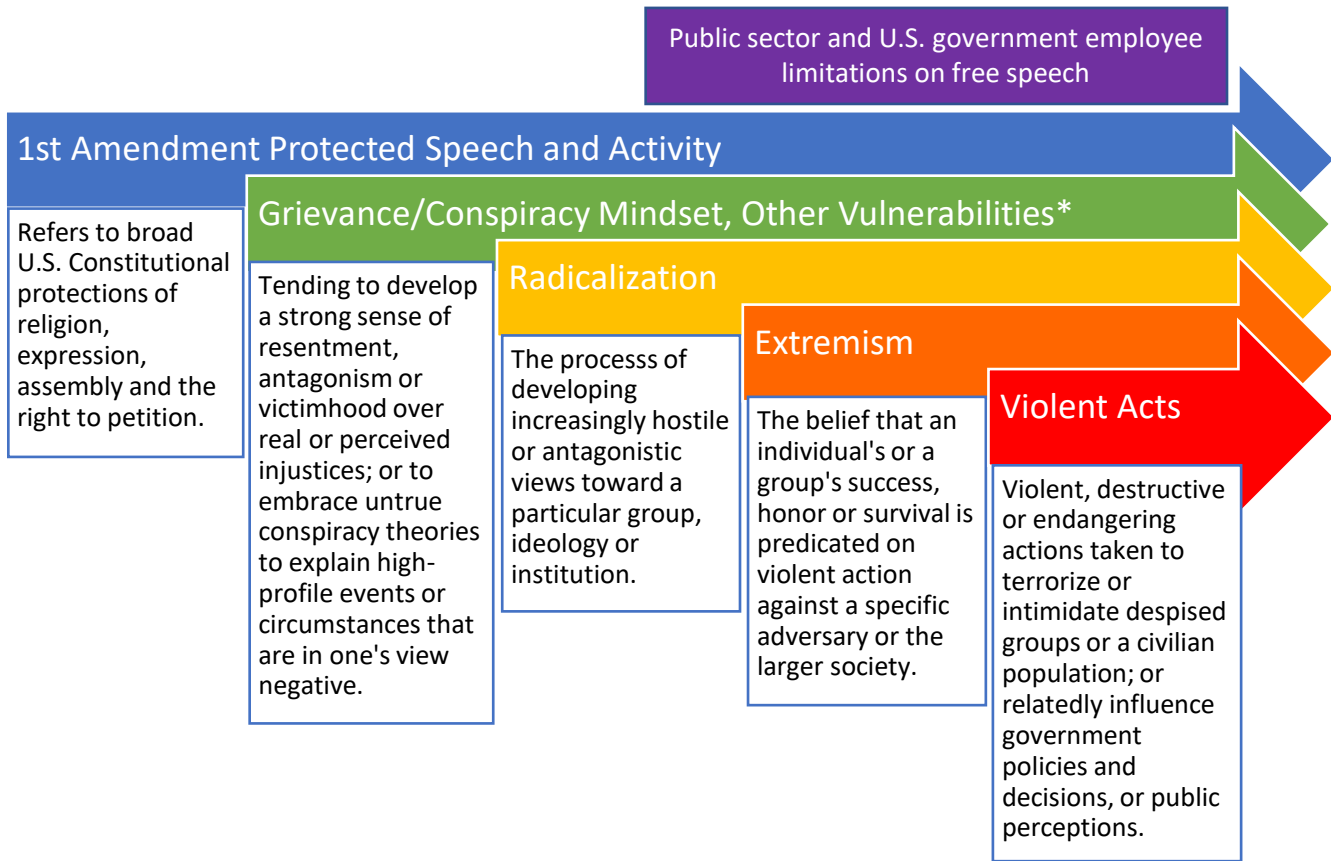


# Development of Extremist Violence Framework



\* Other vulnerabilities to radicalization can include family or cultural influences; extreme social isolation or marginalization; repeated thwarting of occupational goals; maladaptive personality traits like spite and contempt; and certain psychiatric or neurocognitive impairments.
