health problems. Dental and oral health problems are a leading cause of discomfort. Periodontal disease harbors bacteria that can threaten the quality of life and cause serious infection.

Residents with their natural teeth and/or dentures should be seen by a dentist every 3 to 6 months depending on the quality of their daily oral hygiene care. This will contribute to the quality of seniors' lives by ensuring that they enjoy their meals and are able to chew their food properly. Routine exams and cleanings help avoid more serious and costly dental problems and is the key to having a healthy, confident, beautiful smile.
