Director's report – Mary Jane Brown shared Cynthia Richardson's BOD report from October. 6 Thank You notes from Kids at Youth Nationals and 2 from Canadian National exhibitors were passed around for the delegates to read. Mary Jane discussed the August Board Meeting relaying ongoing and sharing the plans to remake the "Modern Arabian Horse" magazine and utilize it more as a membership tool. US Nationals just ended. It was our 50th Anniversary and it was a great show. Pacific Northwest horses and riders dominated the classes.

Committee Reports:

Region 4 Championship Horse Show Commission: Chairperson Connie Chapman reported that the show had suffered a significant financial loss for 2016. A large portion of this is attributed to the last minute cancellation of the cutting classes and the necessity to return all entry fees. Horse numbers were down approximately 20%. In addition to the Cutting cancellation, the Canadian monetary exchange rate was a significant contributing factor. They are already working on the Show Schedule for 2017 and looking at additional ways to reduce the operating budget.

Breeder's Spotlight Ad-Hoc Committee (Sarah Asby, Chana Vanderzanden). Peggy Weems motioned to establish a formal Region 4 Breeder's Spotlight Committee of at least 3 people to select breeders to be honored on the Region 4 website. **MOTION 2016-08** Passed **Unanimously**.

New Business

Motion for approval of R4 sport horse qualifying classes outside the region boundaries by Kaye Phaneuf

- Part of the agreement to allow Donida Farm to host the Region 4 Sport Horse Championships is the assumption that a qualifying pre-show will accompany the championship classes. Following the model used for the Region 5 Sport Horse Championships, the package would be known as the Arabian Salute with Region 4 Sport Horse Championships: 2 days of qualifying + 2 days of championships. AHA numbers, but all one show as far as USEF and USDF are concerned. All classes, including Equitation, to be contained within the Dressage, Western Dressage, Hunter, Jumper, Sport Horse In-Hand/Under Saddle/Show Hack and Carriage Pleasure Driving divisions. Since we all are aware of the perils of 'assume', I respectfully request that approval be expressly given for the above-referenced Region 4 Sport Horse qualifying classes. Said classes to be offered at and by Donida Farm, Auburn, Washington, as part of the Arabian Salute from 2017 through the duration of the Donida Farm/Region 4 Sport Horse Off Site-Championship Show contract. Dates for the 2017 competition to be July 13/14 (pre-show qualifying) and 15/16 (Championships).
- Potential exhibitors have already inquired if R4 Sport Horse qualifying classes will be offered at the Arabian Sport Horse Celebration, the pre-show for Region 5's Sport Horse Off-Site Championships. If this body will approve the inclusion of R4 Sport Horse qualifying classes at the Arabian Sport Horse Celebration to be held at Donida Farm on June 1-4, 2017, then the Celebration show committee will proceed with a cost-benefit analysis. **MOTION 2016-09** Passed **Unanimously.**

Chris Bickford made an additional motion that the Region 4 Board Of Directors waive the rule that approval of a Region 4 Sport Horse Qualifying (only) show outside of Region 4 must be at a face to face BOD meeting. For shows wishing to host Region 4 qualifying classes for the Region 4 Sport Horse Offsite Show held at Donida Farms in 2017 only, approval may be voted on by email or by telephone. MOTION 2016-10 passed unanimously.
